#### **MORTGAGE**

THIS MORTGAGE IS FATED JANUARY 21, 1989, BETWEEN James P. Weaver and Bonnie K. Weaver, husband and wife, whose address is 8041 29th Court, North inverside, IL 60546 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and First American Bank of Riverside, Whose address is 15 Riverside Road, Riverside, IL 60546 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For variable consideration, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and Interest in and to the following described rank property, together with all existing or subsequently erected or affixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and app indences; all water, water rights, watercourses and ditch rights (including stock in utilities with ditch or irrigation rights); and all other rights, royalties, and or offits relating to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Cook County, State of all role (the "Real Property"):

Lot 44 in the Resubdivision of Lots 37 and 38 in Trustees Resubdivision of Lots 1 to 10, both inclusive in Block 4 in Kimbark and Hubbards Subdivision of the South hall of Section 26, Township 39 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian, together with that part of the South 33 feet of the vacated 29th Street, lying East of the center line of Lincoln Avenue, according to the plat of said Resubdivision recorded July 21, 1943 as decument 13111443, in Cook County, Illinois.

The Real Property or its address is commonly known as 3041 29th Court, North Riverside, IL 60546. The Real Property tax Identification number is 15-26-413-025.

Grantor presently assigns to Lender all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to the Rents from the Real Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security Interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage:

Grantor, The word "Grantor" means James P. Weaver and Bonnio K, 'Vervor. The Grantor is the mortgagor under this Mortgage,

improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without "imitation all existing and future improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and similar construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "Indebtedness" means all principal and interest paya" in under the Note and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Grantor or expenses incurred by Lender to entures obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage.

Lender. The word "Lender" means First American Bank of Riverside, its successors of assigns. The Lender is the mortgages under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and Includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Note. The word "Note" means the promissory note or credit agreement dated January 21, 1989. The original amount of \$15,340.20 from Grantor to Lender, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolitations of, and substitutions for the promissory note or agreement together with interest thereon as provided therein. The interest rate on the Note is payable in 60 Monthly payments of \$255.67. The currently scheduled final payment on the Note will be due on or before January 26, 1994.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property owned by Grantor, now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refundably premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, credit agreements, lean agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other documents, whether now or hereafter existing, executed in connection with Granter's Indebtedness to Lender.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all tents, revenues, income, issues, and profits from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that its possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Control from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to

preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been, and never will be so long as this Mortgage remains a lien on the Property, used for the generalion, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened release of any hazardous substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, at seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act ("SARA"), applicable state laws, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to enter upon the Real Property to make such inspections and tests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this paragraph. Any inspections or tests made by Lender shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Lender to Grantor or to any other person. Grantor agrees to Indemnify and hold Lender harmless against any and all claims and losses resulting from a breach of this paragraph of the Mortgage. This obligation to indemnify shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction of this Mortgage.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not demolish or remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements satisfactory to Lender to replace such improvements with improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to are use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in inc Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surety bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor shall do all other nots, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Londor may 1:39 option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written co sent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title or interest therein; whether logal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, deed, installment sale contract, fund contract, contract for deed, leasehold interest with a term greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any honolicial interest in or to any land trust holding little to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Grantonia a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-live percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Granton. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender II exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois aw.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and liens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due before they become delinquent all trixes, payroll taxes, assessments, water charges and sewer service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall have when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's flen, or other flen could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$5,000.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lendon advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of insurance. Grantor shall produce and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extender, coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sutticion, to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Londer of any loss or damage to the Property. Londer may make proof of loss if Grantor falls to do so within lifteon (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Londer may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Londer elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such exponditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 160 days after their receipt and which Lender has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used lirst to pay any amount owing to Lender under this Mortgage, then to prepay accrued interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be applied to the principal balance of the Indebtedness. If Lender holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Grantor.

Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. Il Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Londer on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender deems appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at an annual simple interest rate equivalent to an annual add-on interest rate of \$6.85 per \$100.00 of principal from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Note and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Note, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Note's maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of those amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as curing the default so as to bar Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

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WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Granter warrants that (a) Granter holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee simple, free and clear of all itens and encumbrances other than those set torth in any policy of title insurance issued in layer of or in any title opinion given to, and accepted by, Lender in connection with this Mortgage and (b) Granter has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the tawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

Compilance With Laws. Grantor warrants that its use of the Property compiles with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor, or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. it any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate it the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered, to Lender such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to taxes are a part of this Mortgage,

Taxes Covered. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtodness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Borrower which Borrower is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the Indebtodness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Lender or the holder of the Note; and (d) a specific tax on all o any portion of the Indebtodness or on payments of principal and interest made by Borrower.

Remedies. If any tax to which this section applies it, enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default, and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Granter either (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security satisfactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The 'coloring provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. This instrument shall constitute a security a greenient to the extent any of the Property constitutes dixtures or other personal property, and Lender shall have all of the rights of a secured party under the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Security Interest. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute financing statements and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's security interest in the Rents and Personal Fregerty. In addition to recording this Mortgage in the real property records, Lender may, at any time and without further authorization from Grantor, file executed counterparts, copies or reproductions of this Mortgage as a financing statement. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all expenses incurred in perfecting or continuing this security interest. Upon default, Grantor shall assemble the Personal Property in a manner and at a place reasonably convenient to Grantor and Lender and make it available to Lender within three (3) days after receipt of written demand from Lender.

Addresses. The mailing address of Granter (debter) and the mailing address of Lender (secured party) from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the illinois Uniterm Commercial Code) are as stated on the first page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filled, recorded, re-filled, or re-recorded, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate only and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of trumor assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Note, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and (b) the ienu and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Grantor. Unless prohibited by I is well as the contrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Fact. If Grantor fails to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Londer may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filing, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If all the Indebtedness is paid when due and Grantor performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage and the Note, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and sultable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage:

Default on Indebtedness. Failure of Grantor to make any payment when due on the Indebtedness.

Default on Other Payments. Failure of Grantor within the time required by this Mortgage to make any payment for taxes or insurance, or for any other payment necessary to prevent filling of or to effect discharge of any lien.

Compilance Default. Failure to comply with any other term, obligation, covenant or condition contained in this Mortgage, the Note or in any of the Related Documents. If such a failure is curable and if Grantor has not been given a notice of a breach of the same provision of this Mortgage within the preceding twelve (12) months, it may be cured (and no Event of Default will have occurred) if Grantor, after receiving written notice from Lender demanding cure of such failure: (a) cures the failure with fifteen (15) days; or (b) if the cure requires more than fifteen (15) days, immediately initiates steps sufficient to cure the failure and thereafter continues and completes all reasonable and necessary steps sufficient to

produce compliance as soon as reasonably practical.

Breaches. Any warranty, representation or statement made or turnished to Lender by or on behalf of Grantor under this Mortgage, the Note or the Related Documents is, or at the time made or turnished was, false in any material respect.

insolvency. The insolvency of Grantor, appointment of a receiver for any part of Grantor's property, any assignment for the benefit of creditors, the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against Grantor, or the dissolution or termination of Grantor's existence as a going business (if Grantor is a business). Except to the extent prohibited by federal law or Illinois law, the death of Grantor (if Grantor is an individual) also shall constitute an Event of Default under this Mortgage. However, the death of any Grantor will not be an Event of Default if as a result of the death of Grantor the Indebtedness is fully covered by credit life insurance.

Foreclosure, etc. Commencement of foreclosure, whether by judicial proceeding, self-help, repossession or any other method, by any creditor of Grantor against any of the Property. However, this subsection shall not apply in the event of a good faith dispute by Grantor as to the validity or reasonableness of the claim which is the basis of the foreclosure, provided that Grantor gives Lender written notice of such claim and furnishes reserves or a surety bond for the claim satisfactory to Lender.

Breach of Other Agreement. Any breach by Grantor under the terms of any other agreement between Grantor and Lender that is not remedied within any grace period provided therein, including without limitation any agreement concerning any indebtedness or other obligation of Grantor to Lender, whether existing now or later.

Events Affecting Garrantor. Any of the preceding events occurs with respect to any Guarantor of any of the Indebtedness or such Guarantor dies or becomes incompletent. Lender, at its option, may, but shall not be required to, permit the Guarantor's estate to assume unconditionally the obligations arising under the guaranty in a manner satisfactory to Lender, and, in doing so, cure the Event of Default.

Insecurity. Lender reasons oly deems itself insecure.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEF (U. 7. Upon the occurrence of any event of default and at any time thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and simedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender show have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to declare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penelty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lender shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Illinois Uniform Commorcial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, withou, notice to Grantor, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the not proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use fees directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Grantor irrevocably designates Lender as Grantor's and payments of condense instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Grantor and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Plyments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender's demand shall satisfy the obligations for which the payments are made, whether or not any proper grounds for the demand existed. Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Londer shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by lay, London's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent value of the Property exceeds the Indebtedness by a secundar amount. Employment by London shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property.

Nonjudicial Sale. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may foreclose Grantor's Interest in all or in any part of the Personal Property or the Real Property by nonjudicial sale.

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Lender may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Note or available at law or in equity,

Sale of the Property. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to ner et to property marshalled. If exercising its rights and remedies, Lender shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lender shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Londer shall give Granter reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Projecty or of the time alterwhich any private sale or other intended disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Walver; Election of Remedies. A waiver by any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or projudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remedy, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses.
