In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expent evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of proximing all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title as Mortgage may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this paragraph mentioned, and such expenses and free as may be incurred in the protection of said premises and the acute nature and the lien of this mortgage, including the frees of any attorney employed by Mortgage in any litigation or proceedings affecting this Mortgage. The Note or said premises, including probate and bankruptry proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or thre. - 17. Application of Process of Foreclosure Sale. - 19. Assignment of Rents and Leases. To further secure the indebte ness secured hereby, Mortgagor does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the Mortgagor all the rents, issues and profits now due and which may her infer become due under or by virtue of any lease, whether written or verbal, or any letting of, or of any agreement for the use or ox upancy of the premises or any unit thereof, which may have been heretofore or may be hereafter made or agreed to or which may be made or agreed to by the Mortgagor under the poster herein granted, it being the intention hereby to establish an absolute transfer and assignment of all of such leases and agreements, and all of the avails discretioned, into the Mortgagor, and Mortgagor does hereby appoint irrevocably the Mortgagor its true and lawful attorney in its name and stead (w.d. or without taking possession of the premises as provided in paragraph 19 hereof) to rent, lease or let all or any portion of said premises to any party or parties at such rental and upon such terms as said Mortgagor shall, in its discretion, determine, and to collect all of said avails, rents, issues and profits arising any a or account at any time hereafter, and all now due or that may hereafter become due under each and every of the leases and agreements, written or ved of, or other tenancy existing, or which may hereafter exist on said premises, with the same rights and powers and subject to the same immunities, experience, or hability and rights of recourse and indemnity as the Mortgagor would have upon taking possession pursuant to the provisions of paragraph 20 hereof.

The Mortgagor represents and agrees that no rent has been or will be paid by any person in piscession of any portion of the above described premises for more than one installment in advance and that the payment of none of the rents to accrue for any portion of the said premises has been or will be waived, released, reduced, discounted or otherwise discharged or compromised by the Mortgagor. 20. Mortgagee's Right of Possession in Case of Default.  - (d) to the payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or any deficiency which may result from any foreclosure sale.
- 22. Mortgagee's Right of Inspection. Mortgagee shall have the right to inspect the premises at all reasonable times and access thereto shall be permitted for that purpose.
- 23. Late Charge. - 24. Condemnation. - 25. Release upon Payment and Discharge of Mortgagor's Obligations. Mortgages shall release this mortgage and the lien thereof by proper instrument upon payment and discharge of all indebtedness secure I hereby and payment of a reasonable fee to Mortgages for the preparation and execution of such release.
- 26. Giving of Notice. Any notice which either party hereto may desire of or required to give to the other party shall be in writing and the mailing thereof by certified mail addressed to the Mortgagor at the mortgaged premise; (d'segnated by strict address) or to the Mortgagoe, at its principal office in Chicago, Illinois to the attention of the office of the Vice President in charge of the animalu-family real estate loans and specifying the loan number, or at such other place within the United States as any party hereto may by notice r. v. iting designate as a place for service of notice, shall constitute service of notice hereinder. Any notice given by the Mortgagoe shall be deemed given on the date the same is deposited in the United States mails.
- 27. Waiver of Defense. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same in an action at law upon the Note he ely secured.
- 29. Mortgagee's Lien for Service Charges and Expenses. At all times, regardless of whether any loan procees's have been disbursed, this Mortgage secures (in addition to any loan proceeds disbursed from time to time) the payment of any and all loan commissions, service charges, biquidated damages, expenses and advances due to or incurred by the Mortgagee in connection with the loan to be secured hereby, rill in accordance with the application and loan commitment issued in connection with this transaction.
- 30. Furnishing of Financial Statements to Mortgagee. Upon request, Mortgager shall furnish to Mortgagee, a semi-annual operating statement of income and expense of the mortgaged premises signed and certified by the Mortgagor's beneficiary or beneficiaries.
- 31. Cumulative Rights. Each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon the Mortgagee is cumulative of every other right or remedy of the Mortgagee, whether herein or by law conferred, and may be enforced concurrently therewith.
- 32. Binding on Successors and Assigns. The lien of this Mortgage and all of the provisions and conditions contained herein shall extend to and be binding upon all successors and assigns of the Mortgagee. The word "Mortgagee" when used herein shall include the successors and assigns of the Mortgagee named herein, and the holder or holders, from time to time, of the Note secured hereby.
- 33. Captions. The captions and headings of various paragraphs of this Mortgage are for convenience only and are not to be construed as defining or limiting, in any way, the scope or intent of the provisions hereof.
- THIS MORTGAGE is executed by the undersigned, not personally but as Trustee as aforesaid in the exercise of the power and authority conferred upon and vested in it as such Trustee and said (Corporation) (Association) hereby warrants that it possesses full power and authority to execute this instrument, and it is expressly understood and agreed that nothing herein or in the Note contained shall be construed as creating any limbility on the said Mortgagor or on said (Corporation) (Association) personally to pay the Note or any interest that may accrue thereon, or any indebtedness accruing hereinder, or to perform any covenant either express or implied herein contained (it being understood and agreed that each of the provisions hereo, except the warranty hereinabove contained in this execution clause, shall constitute a condition and not a covenant or agreement, regardless of whether the same may be concluded in language of a promise or covenant or agreement), all such liability, if any, being expressly waived by Mortgagee and by every person now or hereafter claiming any right or security hereunder, and that so far as the Mortgagor and its successors and said (Corporation) (Association) personally are concerned, the legal holder or holders of the Note and the owner or owners of any indebtedness accruing hereunder shall look solely to any one or more of: (1) the premises hereby conveyed and the ients, issues and profits thereof, for the payment thereof, by the enforcement of the lien hereby created, in the manner herein and in the Note provided; (2) any other security given to secure said indebtedness; or (3) the personal liability of the guarantor, co-signor, surety or endorser, if any.

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
