2. The said Assessment Roll and Report and all proceedings therein be and the same are hereby confirmed and judgment of confirmation by default is hereby entered against each lot, block, tract and parcel of land as described in and for the amount set forth in said Assessment Roll and Report as returned by the Commissioners and filed herein and for each installment thereof, except for the lots, blocks, tracts and parcels for which objections have been filed herein and the lots, blocks, tracts or parcels of property in which Amoco Oil Company, Lake

4. That certain legal and beneficial objections have been or will be filed as to certain lots, blocks, tracts and parcels of land and the hearing on legal objections is set on the 6th day of February, 1989, at 2:00 p.m., and the hearing on beneficial objections and to ascertain the just compensation to be made for private or public property to be taken or damaged for construction of said improvement is set on the 7th day of February, 1989 at 9:30 a.m.

3. That Amoco Oil Company, Lake River Terminal Company, Petroleum Fuel & Terminal Company and the Metropolitan Sanitary District are granted leave to file their appearances and objections as to lots, blocks, tracts or parcels of property in which they are interested on or before December 27, 1988

2. That the said lots, blocks, tracts and parcels of land for which default has been entered were properly assessed, that the assessment shown against such property in the Assessment Roll and Report does not exceed the proportionate share of the cost of the improvement, and that it does not exceed the amount of benefits to the said property resulting from the improvement.
