

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cod.

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person fiable in pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be alten in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the hability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of auch State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Scientia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be altuated -

(A) Rest Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, at the residence of the laxpa er at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For humboses of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partn (shi) shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal werdows office of the business is focated, and the residence of the principal werdows residence is without the United States shall be often ac to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - the from and content of the notice referred it in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice chall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regalding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(p) Refilling Of Notice, — For purposes of this section.

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (t)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of tien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only.

(A) if

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recarded in an index to the extent required by Subsection (f) (4), and

(E) In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refining of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filled in accordance with suits action (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — In the case of any notice of ilen, the term "tequired refilling period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release of Lian Or Discharge of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such teriulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of refease of any flen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or

(?) Bond Accapted - There is furnished to the Secretary and accented by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the Nicount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of sulfit time), and that is in accordance with such requirements as a fing to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereo. At may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien + If a notice of tien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
