

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interst, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, or with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property nd rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien Imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so essed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

b) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security inets, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment of Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 8321 shall nd valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security pt, mechanic's Henor, or judgment lien creditor until notice which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has led by the Secretary.

m Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such Stats, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the iten is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has frot by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject to Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, men or tangible or intangible, at the residence of the texpeyer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or parts ver p shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal axi cutt a "Thos of the business is located, and the residence of a law type whose residence is without the United States shall be dee ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The form and centent of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shift by valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regulator, the form or content of a

- (g) Refliting Of Notice. For purposes of this section
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of tien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -(A) # -
 - (i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of tien was flied, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
 - (8) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the 'm prescribed in regulations issued by the Secret concerning a change in the texpeyor's residence, if a n ence, if a noti of such Hen is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) to the State in which such residence is legated.

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(a) Required Refilling Parisd. — in the se of any notice of flee, the term "required refilling period" me (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 ye after the close of the preceding required raffling period for such notice of Hen.

Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. 6325. Sec.

- (a) Release Of Lieft. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount accessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and no mitted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of thereof within the time prescribed by law (includ extension of area time), and that is in accordance with such requirements, elsing to terms, conditions, and form of the tiend and sureties thurs... as may be specified by such regulation

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

- (k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien. If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or inlends to obtain a right in such property.
