

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cod's

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax regiects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by eaction 6221 aixis arise at the time the assessment is made and shall commune until the hability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Pyrchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craditors. — The lien imposed by section 8321 shall not be visit as against any purchaser, holder of a security interests/mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Rice For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental, subdivision), as designated by the laws of stoch State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Parsonal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangole or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the tien is situated:

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has "not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal preperty, whather tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpi yer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

Fol ourposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or parallels in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal carbon of the business is located, and the residence of a figurality whose residence is without the United States shall be due ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (4) shall be prescribed by the Sectiary. Such notice that the valid notwithstanding any other provision of taw regularly the form or content of a notice of lien.

Note: See section 6323(b) [5] protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Motor vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased at retail
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- Personal property subjected to possessory lien.

- 7. Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this section.
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien as refued in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is fried (in accordance with subsection II). after the apprecion of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of men refried during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A) if -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refining is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection. (f). (4), and

(8) in any case in which 90 days or mine prior to the date of a refilling of notice of lien under supparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expitation of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the taxx, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expitation of 6 years after the close of the proceding required refiling period fer such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lieft. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which-
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and accorded by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, which the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements or iting to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suffeties dieffort, as may be specified by such repulsitions.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Raturns and Return Information.

risi Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. ---

(2) Discrosure of amount or outstanding field in the notice of field has been filed pursuant to section 6320(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such field may be disclosed to any person who furnishes set/sfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such field or intends to obtain a right in such property.
