ORDINANCE NO. 2964

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
VILLAGE OF GLENVIEW
SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER TWELVE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Villag of Glenview, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Special Service Area Number Twelve is established pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Sections 6: and 6L of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and pursuant to:

The General Assembly may not deny or limit the power of home rule units (1) to make local improvements by special assessment and to exercise this power jointly with other counties and municipalities, and other classes of units of local government having that power on the effective date of this Constitution unless that power is subsequently senied by law to any such other units of local government, or (2) to levy or impose additional taxes upon areas within their boundaries in the manner provided by law for the provision of special services to those areas and for the payment of debt incurred in order to provide those special services.

Section 2: A. The question of the establishment of the area hereinafter described as a special service area is considered by the Village Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 2944 entitled: Ordinance Proposing the Establishment of a Special Service Area in the Village of Glenview and Providing for a Jublic Hearing and Other Procedures in Connection Therewith", adopted December 13, 1988, and is considered pursuant to a hearing held on Vanuary 10, 1989 by the Village Board pursuant to notice duly published in the News/Voice, December 14, 1988, a newspaper published in the Glenview Area, at least fifteen (15) days prior to the hearing and pursuant to Notice by mail addressed to the person or pursons in whose name the general taxes for the last preceding year were paid on each lot, block, tract or parcel of land lying within the special service area. Said Notice was given by depositing said Notice in the United States Mails not less than ten (10) days prior to the time set for the public hearing. In the event taxes for the last preceding year were not paid, said Notice was sent to the person listed on the tax rolls prior to that year as the owner of said property. A Certificate of Publication of said Notice and an Affidavit of mailing of said Notice are attached to this ordinance as Exhibits 1 and 2. Said Notices conformed in all respects to the requirements of Section 5 of Public Act 78-901, aforesaid.

- B. That a public hearing on the question set forth in the Notice was held on January 10, 1989. All interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on the question of the creation of the special service area and on the issuance of bonds as set forth in the Notice. The public hearing was adjourned on January 10, 1989.
- C. That after considering the data, as presented at the public hearing, the Board of Trustees finds that it is in the public interest and in the interest of the Village of Glenview special service Area Number Twelve that said special service area, as hereinafter described, be established.
- D. Said area is compact and contiguous and constitutes a single remily residential area known as Queens Lane in the Village of Glenview.
- E. It is in the best interest of said special service area that the furnishing of the municipal services proposed be considered for the common interests of said area.
- F. Said area is zoned single family and will benefit specially from municipal service proposed to be provided. The proposed municipal service is unique and in addition to the municipal services provided to the Village of Glenview as a whole.
- Section 3: The Village of Glenview Special Service Area Number Twelve Established. A Special Service Area to be known and designated as "Village of Glenview Special Service Area Number Twelve" is hereby established and shall consist of the following described territory:
- East 1/2 Lot 14, Lots 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 in Block 3 and Lots 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 in Blocks 4 in the Fourth Addition to Elen Oak Acres, a subdivision in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 42 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Neridian in Cook County, Illinois.
- Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in Pick 1 and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 in Block 2 in the Fifth Addition to Glen Oak Acres, a subdivision of the North 20 acres of the South east 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 42 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian in Cook County, Illinois.

The approximate commonly known street location are as follows: Queens have 902, 903, 906, 907, 911, 914, 917, 918, 920, 922, 923, 931, 937, 938, 940, 941, 942, 1000, 1005, 1010, 1014, 1017, 1022, 1025, 1035, 1036.

Section 4: Village of Glenview Special Service Area Number Twelve is established to provide special municipal services to the area, including the installation of watermain system and all appurtenances thereto, the furnishing of all necessary labor and materials in connection therewith and other similar types of amenities and improvements compatible with the proposed improvement plan. Village of Glenview Special Service Area Number Twelve is also created so that bonds may be issued, for the purposes aforesaid, payable from taxes levied on property in the Special Service area in addition to all other Village taxes so levied, provided no bonds shall be issued in excess of the principal amount of \$103,350.00 or at an interest rate to exceed Ten (10.00) parcent per annum and said bonds to mature within Twenty (20) years from date.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of March 21, 1929, providing no valid petition is filed opposing the creation of the Special Service area pursuant to Chapter 120, Illinois Revised Statutes, Section 1309.


