

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cody

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition theretol shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the fien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the flability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Graditors. — The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not behalf as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienar, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(i) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the cierk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to fien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Geeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Beeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of ceal property, at its physical location or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, and ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpuyer at the time the notice of flen is filed.

For jurisors of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partners to shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal erecur ve office of the business is located, and the residence of units awar whose residence is without the United States shall be on med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though rotice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Motor vehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased at retail.
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- Personal property subjected to possessory lien

- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements

(p) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section.

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of then is refilled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of then shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) when the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of iten relied during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

(A) ij -

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of fien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a rellling of notice of iten under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 5 years after the date of the assessment of the tax; and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 5 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Referse Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully eatisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding flen. If a notice of flen has been titled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such flen may be disclosed to have person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such flen or intends to obtain a right in such property.
