TO HAVE AND TO HOLD such property unto Lencer and Lender's successors and assigns, lorever, together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, after-acquired title or reversion in and to the ueds of ways, streets, avenues, and alleys adjoining the Property, and rents (subject however to the rights and authorities given in this Mortgage to Lender to collect and apply such rents), royalties, mineral, oil, and ga, rights and profits, water, water rights, and water stock, insurance and condemnation proceeds, and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to the property, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto, shall be duemed to be and remain a part of the property covered by this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing, together with said property (or the leasehold estate if this Mortgage is on a leasehold) are hereinafter referred to at the "Property", as to any property which does not constitute a fixture (as such term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), this Mortgage is hereby deemed to be, as well, a Security Agreement under the UCC for the purpose of creating a security interest in such Property, which Borrower hereby grants to Lender as Secured Part (as such term is defined in the UCC);

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Mortgage, the Property shall include all of Borrower's right, title, and interest in and to the real property described above, whether such right, title, and interest is acquired before or after execution of this Mortgage. Specifically, and without limitation of the foregoing, if this Mortgage is given with respect to a leasehold estate held by Borrower, and Borrower subsequently acquires a free interest in the real property, the lien of this Mortgage shall attach to and include the fee interest acquired by Borrower.

Borrower covenants that Borrower is the lawful owner of the estate in land hereby conveyed and has the right to grant, convey, and mortgage the Property, and that the Property is unencumbered except for encumbrances of record. Borrower covenants that Borrower warrants and will defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to encumbrances of record. Borrower covenants that Borrower will neither take nor permit any action to partition or subdivide the Property or otherwise change the legal description of the Property or any part thereof, or change in any way the condition of title of the Property or any part thereof.

Borrower acknowledges that the Agreement calls for a "variable interest rate," and that the Lender may, prior to the expiration of the term of the Agreement cancel future advances thereunder and/or require repayment of the outstanding balance under the Agreement. In this regard, the Agreement provisions set forth verbatim below relate to the variable interest rate and the Lender's option to require repayment prior to expiration of the term of the Agreement or to cancel future advances for reasons other than default by the Borrower.

FINANCE CHARGE: Borrowers agree to pay a Periodic Finance Charge on the Average Daily Balance of their account beginning on the date any advance or other charge is added to the account. The Average Daily Balance for a billing period is computed by adding the unpaid balances on the account at the end of each day during the billing period and dividing the total by the number of days in the billing period. The unpaid balance at the end of each day shall be determined by adding to the previous day's unpaid balance all advances and other charges, except Periodic Finance Charge, occurring that day, and subtracting from such amount all payments made by Borrowers and other credits. The Periodic Finance Charge is calculated at the end of each billing period by multiplying the Daily Periodic Rate in effect at the time by the number of days in the period, and then multiplying the Average Daily Balance during the billing period by the resulting rate. The Periodic Finance Charge rates under this Agreement as of the date of this Agreement are:

The Daily Periodic Rate is the Annual Percentage Rate divided by 365. The Annual Percentage Rate and Corresponding Daily Periodic Rate described in the Agreement are applicable to all balances under this Agreement. In addition to periodic Finance Charge at the Annual Percentage Rate show above, Borrowers agree to pay a Prepaid Finance Charge of \$ 0.00 immediately upon the establishment of the Line of Credit provided under this Agreement. Borrowers agree that if they do not pay the Prepaid Finance Charge in cash, it will be added to the unvaid balance on the account under this Agreement, and will bear interest at the Annual Percentage Rate.

Borrower agrees not to pay the Prepaided Finance Charge with a money draft drawn on this Line of Credit.

The paragraph of the Equity Advantage Loan Agreement and Disclosure Statement, entitle "USE OF DRAFTS," provides in its entirety the lollowing conditions:

USE OF DRAFTS: Borrowers agree that if Lender provides them with money drafts to be used for the purpose of taking advances on Borrowers' Line of Credit, their use of such money drafts shall be subject to the following limitations: (a) No money draft may be negotiated with a face amount of less than \$500.00; (b) Money drafts may not be used for the purpose of making payments under this Agreement: (c) No money draft may be negotiated if Borrowers are in default under any of the terms of this Agreement; (d) No money draft may be negotiated if the unpaid balance under this Agreement is in excess of the Line of Credit or if such money draft would itself cause the unpaid balance of this Agreement to be in excess of the Line of Credit; (e) No money draft may be negotiated after the Date on Which Line of Credit Terminates; (f) All money drafts are and remain the property of Lender, and all money drafts must be returned to Lender upon Lender's request or after the Date on Which Line of Credit Terminates; (g) Lender is not liable for any refusal to honor Borrowers' money drafts or for any retention of a money draft by Lender, any other creditor, or any seller of goods or services, or for any notice Lender may give that Lender reluses to honor a money draft; and (h) Borrowers are liable for the unauthorized use of Borrowers' money drafts. Borrowers should immediately notify Lender, orally and in writing, of the loss, theft, or possible unauthorized use of Borroyle's' money drafts.

The paragraph of the Equity Advantage Loan Agreement and Disciorure, entitle "OVER-LIMIT REQUESTS," provides in its entirety the following conditions:

The paragraph of the Equity Advantage Loan Agreement and Disclosure Statement, entitled "FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH TERMS OF AGREEMENT," provides as follows:

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH TERMS OF AGREEMENT: Borrowers agree that if they fail to comply with any of the terms of this Agreement or any other document signed by them in connection with this Agreement or, if one or more Borrowers die or have made any misrepresentations in connection with this Agreement, Lender may without notice require Borrowers to immediately pay the entire unpaid balance of this Agreement, including accrued Periodic Finance Charge. Lender also has this right if there is a material adverse charge in Borrowers' financial condition or credit standing, if Borrowers become subject to bankruptcy proceedings or if Borrowers do anything that indicates they are unable or unwilling to repay this loan. Once Lender has declared the entire unpaid balance due, the Line of Credit under this Agreement is terminated. In addition, Borrowers agree that Lender may without notice and at any time require Borrowers to pay all or any part of the unpaid balance of this loan, including accrued Finance Charge, if the property given by Borrowers to secure this loan declines in value to the extent that Lender, at its sole discretion, deems itself insecure.

The paragraph of the Equity Advantage Loan Agreement and Disclosure Statement, entitled "PREPAYMENT PENALTY," provides as follows:

# COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender covenant

- 1. PAYMENT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST. Borrower shall promptly pay when due, in accordance with the terms of the Note, the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, together with any late charges or other charges imposed under this Note.
- 2. APPLICATION OF PAYMENTS. Unless applicable law requires otherwise, all payments received by Lender under the Note and this Mortgage shall be applied by Lender first in payment of amounts payable to Lender by Borrower under paragraphs 6 and 26 of this Mortgage, then to interest payment on the Note, then to other charges payable under the Note, and then to the principal of the Note.
- 3. PRIOR MORTGAGES AND DEEDS OF TRUST; CHARGES; LIENS. Borrower shall fully and timely perform all of Borrower's obligations under any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement with a lien which has or appears to have any priority over this Mortgage, including Borrower's covenants to make any payments when due. Borrower shall pay or cause to be paid, at least 10 days before delinquency, all taxes, assessments, and other charges, fines, and impositions attributable to the Property and all encumbrances, charges, loans, and liens (other than any prior first mortgage or deed of trust) on the Property which may attain any priority over this Mortgage, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any. Borrower shall deliver to Lender, upon its request. receipts evidencing such payments.
- 4. HAZARD INSURANCE. Borrower shall, at its cost, keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage," and such other hazards (collective), referred to as "Hazards") as Lender may require. Borrower shall maintain hazard insurance for the entire term of the Note or such other periods as Lender may require and in an amount equal to the lesser of: (a) the maximur, insurable value of the Property; or (b) the amount of the credit secured by this Mortgage plus the outstanding arrivant of any obligation secured in priority over this Mortgage, but in no event shall such amounts be less than the arount necessary to satisfy the coinsurance requirement contained in the insurance policy.

The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to approval by Lender; provided, that such approval shall not be uneconably withheld. All insurance policies and renewals thereof shall be in a form acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in a form acceptable to Lender. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals thereof, subject to the terms of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement with a lien which has or appears to have any priority over this Mortgage. If Borrower makes the premium payment directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all renewal notices and, if requested by Lender, make's the premium payment directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all renewal notices and, if request 2 by Lender, all receipts of paid premiums. If policies and renewals are held by any other person, Borrower shall supply copies of such to Lender within 10 calendar days after issuance.

In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Subject to the rights and terms of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement with a lien which has or appears to have any priority over this Mortgage, the amounts collected by Borrower or Lender under any Hazard insurance policy may, at Lender's sole discretion, either be applied to the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage and in such order as Lender may determine or be released to Borrower for use in repairing or reconstructing the

PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF PROPERTY; LEASEHOLDS; CONDOMINIUMS; PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENTS. Borrower shall use, improve and maintain the Property in compliance with applicable laws, statutes, ordinances, orders, requirements, decrees, or regulations, shall keep the Property in good condition and repair, including the repair or restoration of any improvements on the Property which may be damaged or destroyed, shall not commit or permit waste or permit impairment or deterioration of the Property, and shall fully and promptly comply with the provisions of any lease if this Mortgage is on a leasehold. If this Mortgage is on a unit in a condominium or a planned unit development, Borrower shall promptly perform all of Borrower's obligations under the declaration or covenants creating or governing the condominium or a planned unit development, the by-laws and regulations of the condominium or a planned unit development, and constituent documents, all as may be amended from time to time. If a condominium or a planned unit development rider is executed by Borrower and recorded together with this Mortgage, the covenants and agreements of such rider shall be incorporated into and shall amend and supplement the covenants and agreements of this Mortgage as if the rider were a part of this Mortgage.



6. PROTECTION OF LENDER'S SECURITY. If Burrower rats to perform the governality and agreements contained in this Mortgage or in the Note or if any action or proceeding is commenced which affects. Lender's interest in the Property or the rights or powers of Lender, then Lender without demand upon Borrower but upon notice to Borrower pursuant to paragraph 11 of this Mortgage, may, without releasing Borrower from any obligation in this Mortgage, make such appearances, defend the action or proceeding, disburse such sums, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and take such action as Lender deems necessary to protect the security of this Mortgage. If Lender has required mortgage insurance as a condition of making the loan secured by this Mortgage, Borrower shall pay the premiums required to maintain such insurance in effect until such time as the requirement for such insurance terminates in accordance with Borrower's and Lender's written agreement or applicable law.

Any amounts disbursed by Lender pursuant to this paragraph 6, with interest thereon at the rate from time to time in effect under the Note, shall become additional indebtedness of Borrower secured by this Mortgage. Unless Borrower and Lender agree, in writing, to other terms of payment, such amounts shall be payable upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment thereof. Nothing contained in this paragraph 6 shall require Lender to incur any expense or take any action hereunder and any action taken shall not release Borrower from any obligation in this Mortgage.

- 7. INSPECTION. Lender may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property, provided that, except in an emergency, Lender shall give Borrower notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefor related to Lender's interest in the Property.
- B. CONDEMICATION. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of the property, or part thereof, or for conveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender, subject to the terms of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement with a lien which has priority over this Mortgage. Borrower agrees to execute such further documents as may be required by the condemnation authority to effectuate this paragraph. Lender is hereby irrevocably authorized to apply or release such moneys received or make settlement for such moneys in the same manner and with the same check as provided in this Mortgage for disposition or settlement of proceeds of Hazard insurance. No settlement for convernation damages shall be made without Lender's prior written approval.
- 9. BORROWER NOT RELEASED; FORZEARANCE BY LENDER NOT A WAIVER. Extension of the time for payment, acceptance by Lender of payments other than accurding to the terms of the Note, modification in payment terms of the sums secured by this Montgage granted by Lender to any successor in interest of Borrower, or the waiver or failure to exercise any right granted in this Mortgage or under the Note shall not operate to release, in any manner, the liability of the original Borrower, Borrower's successors in interest, or any guarantor or surety thereof. Lender shall not be required to commence procedings against such successor or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify payment terms of the sums securer' by this Mortgage by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower and Borrower's successors in interest. I ader shall not be deemed, by any act of omission or commission, to have waived any of its rights or remedies under this Mortgage unless such waiver is in writing and signed by Lender. Any such waiver shall apply only to the eitent specifically set forth in the writing. A waiver as to one event shall not be construed as continuing or as a waiver as to any other event. The procurement of insurance or the payment of taxes, other liens or charges by Lender shall not be a waiver of Lender's right as otherwise provided in this Mortgage to accelerate the maturity of the inceptedness secured by this Mortgage in the event of Borrower's default under this Mortgage or the Note.
- 10. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS BOUND; JOINT AND SEVERAL LAFTLITY; CO-SIGNERS. The coverants and agreements contained in this Mortgage shall bind, and the rights under this Mortgage shall inure to, the respective successors, heirs, legatees, devisees, and assigns of Lender and Borrower subject to the provisions of paragraph 16 of this Mortgage. All covenants and agreements of Borrower (or Borrower's successors, heirs, legatees, devisees, and assigns) shall be joint and several. Any Borrower who co-signs, this Mortgage, but does not execute the Note, (a) is co-signing this Mortgage only to encumber that Borrower's lite est in the Property under the lien and terms of this Mortgage and to release homestead rights, if any, (b) is not personally liable on the Note or under this Mortgage, and (c) agrees that Lender and any other Borrower under this Nortgage may agree to extend, modify, forebear, or make any other accommodations with regard to the terms of this Mortgage or the Note without that Borrower's consent and without releasing that Borrower or modifying this Mortgage as to that Borrower's interest in the Property.
- 11. NOTICES. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in anothe, manner: (a) any notice to Borrower (or Borrower's successors, heirs, legatees, devisees, and assigns) provided for in this Mortgage shall be given by hand-delivering it addressed to Borrower (or Borrower's successors, heirs, legatees, and assigns) at the Property Address or at such other address as Borrower (or Borrower's successors, heirs, legatees, devisees, and assigns) may designate by written notice to Lender as provided in this Mortgage; and (b) any notice to Lender shall be given by registered or certified mail to such address as Lender may designate by written notice to Borrower (or Borrower's successors, heirs, legatees, devisees, and assigns) as provided in this Mortgage. Any notice provided for in this Mortgage shall be deemed to have been given on the date hand delivery is actually made or the date notice is deposited into the U.S. mail system as registered or certified mail addressed as provided in this paragraph 11.
- 12. GOVERNING LAW; SEVERABILITY. The state and local laws applicable to this Mortgage shall be the laws of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. The foregoing sentence shall not limit the applicability of tederal law to this Mortgage. If any provision of this Mortgage shall be adjudged invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by any court, such provision shall be deemed stricken from this Mortgage and the balance of the Mortgage shall be construed as if such provision had never been included. As used in this Mortgage, "costs," "expenses" and "attorneys' fees" include all sums to the extent not prohibited by applicable law or limited in this Mortgage.
- 13. BORROWER'S COPY. Borrower shall be furnished a copy of the Note and of this Mortgage at the time of execution or after recordation of this Mortgage.

14. REMEDIES CUMULATIVE. Lender shall exercise all of the rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage and in the Note or which may be available to Lender by law, and all such rights and remedies shall be cumulative and concurrent, and may be pursued singly, successively, or together, at Lender's sole discretion, and may be exercised as often as occasion therefor shall occur.

### 15. EVENTS OF DEFAULT.

- a. Notice and Grace Period. An Event of Default will occur under this Mortgage upon the expiration of the applicable grace period, if any, after Lender gives written notice to Borrower's breach or violation of Borrower's covenants under the Note and upon Borrower's failure to cure such breach or violation, and to provide Lender, during that grace period, if any, with evidence reasonably satisfactory to it of such cure. In each case, the grace period begins to run on the day after the notice is given, and expires at 11:59 p.m., Central Time, on the last day of the period. If there is no grace period applicable to a particular breach or violation, the Event of Default will occur under this Mortgage upon the giving of the above notice. Such notice shall be given to Borrower in accordance with paragraph 11 of this Mortgage and shall contain the following information: (1) the nature of the Borrower's breach or violation; (2) the action, if any, required or permitted to cure such breach or violation; (3) the applicable grace period, if any, during which such breach or violation must be cured; and (4) whether failure to cure such breach or violation within the specified grace period, if any, will result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage and the potential foreclosure of this Mortgage. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right, if any, under applicable law, to reinstate his credit under this Mortgage after acceleration.
- Events of Driault. Set forth below is a list of events which, upon the lapse of the applicable grace period, if any, will rostitute Events of Default. (Applicable grace periods are set forth parenthetically after each event.) The events are: (1) Borrower fails to pay when due any amounts due under the Note or this Mortgage (30-day grace period); (2) Borrower fails to keep the covenants and other promises made in the Note (no grace period); (3) Lender receives actual knowledge that Borrower omitted material information in Borrower's credit application (no grace period) or made any false or misleading statements on Borrower's credit application (no grace period); (4) Borrower dos or changes his or her marital status and transfers Borrower's interest in the Property to someone who either (i) is not also a signatory of the Note (no grace period), or (ii) is a signatory of the Note if such transfer, in Lende's reasonable judgment, materially impairs the security for the credit described in the Note (no grace period); (5) Borrower files for bankruptcy, or bankruptcy proceedings are instituted against Borrower and not dismissed within 60 calendar days, under any provision of any state or federal bankruptcy law in effect at the time of him (no grace period); (6) Borrower makes an assignment for the benefit of his or her creditors, becomes insolven, c. becomes unable to meet his or her obligations generally as they become due (no grace period); (7) Borrowei further encumbers the Property, or suffers a lien, claim of lien, or encumbrance against the Property (30-day grace amod in which to remove the lien, claim or lien, or encumbrance); (8) Borrower defaults or an action is filed alleging a default under any credit instrument or mortgage evidencing or securing an obligation of Borrower with priority in right of payment over the line of credit described in the Note or whose lien has or appears to have any priority over the lien hereof (no grace period), or any other creditor of Borrower attempts to (or actual does) seize or obtain a writ of attachment against the Property (no grace period); (9) Borrower fails to keep any other covenant contained in the Note or this Mortgage not otherwise specified in this paragraph 15 (10-day grace period, unless the failure is by its nature not curable, in which case no grace period or, if another grace period is specified in the Note or this Mortgage that grace period shall
- 16. TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY. If the Borrower, or beneficially of 2 Trust, if any, sells, conveys, assigns, or transfers, or promises or contracts to sell, convey, assign, or transfer, all or any part of the beneficial interest in the Trust, if any, or amends or terminates any ground leases affecting the Property, or if title to the Property, or any direct or indirect interest therein, is otherwise sold or transferred, voluntarily or involuntarily, including without limitation sale or transfer in any proceeding for foreclosure or judicial sale of the Property or beneficial interest in the Trust, if any, in each case without Lender's prior written consent, Lender shall be entitled to immediately accelerate the amounts due under the Note and declare all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable as set forth in the Note Failure to pay such indebtedness within 30 days after the notice to Borrower of such acceleration shall constitute an Event of Default.

As an alternative to declaring all sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable, Lender may waive its option to accelerate and agree in writing, prior to close of the sale or transfer or tile promise to sellor transfer, to the transferee's assumption of the outstanding obligation under the Note on terms satisfactory to tender. Lender's acceptance of the transferee's assumption of the obligation under the Note shall not release. The transferee and Borrower shall retain the right to repay the Note before the Due Date, in whole or in part, at any time without premium or penalty.

- 17. ACCELERATION; REMEDIES. Such date shall be conclusively determined by reference to the return receipt in possession of Borrower. If such return receipt is not available, such date shall be conclusively determined by reference to the "Received" date stamped on such written notice by Lender or Lender's agent. With regard to other events or information not provided by Borrower under the Note, Lender will be deemed to have actual knowledge of such event or information as of the date Lender receives a written notice of such event or information from a source Lender reasonably believes to be reliable, including, but not limited to, a court or other governmental agency institutional lender, or title company. The actual date of receipt shall be determined by reference to the "Received" rate stamped on such written notice by Lender or Lender's agent.
- 24. TAXES. In thee vent of the passage after the date of the Mortgage of any law changing in any way the laws now in force for the taxation of mortgages, or debts secured thereby, or the manner of operation of such taxes, so as to affect the interest of Lender, then and in such event Borrower shall pay the full amount of such taxes.
- 25. WAIVER OF STATUTORY RIGHTS. Borrower shall not and will not apply for or avail uself of any homestead, or any so-called "peratorium laws" now appraisement, valuation, redemption, stay, extension, or exemption laws, or any so-called "incratorium laws," now existing or hereafter enacted, in order to prevent or hinder the enforcement or foreclosure or this Mortgage, but hereby waives the benefit of such laws.
