

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Coar

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax naglects or refuses to pay the sarin after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layer of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lienimposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the essenment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unanforceable by reason of laosa of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The Hen Imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's llenor, or judgment tien creditor until natice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing . The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State for the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has pot by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the hen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or (B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property,

whether langible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of flen is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (5), the residence of a corporation or part are in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive cities of the business is located, and the residence of a recovery whose residence is without the United States shall be dee ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice should valid notwithstanding any other provision of taw regulation the form or content of a notice of linn.

(g) Reffling Of Notice. - For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. - Unless notice of then is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (ii)) after the expiration of such railling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of then retilled during the required refilling period shall be effective only

(A) if -

(i) such notice of tien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by \mathbb{C} subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. Sec.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Sueject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unanterceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount passessed, together with all Interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or
(2) Bend Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and act 19 and by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assucced, together with mil interest in respect thereof, within the lime prescribed by law (including any extension of each time), and that is in accordance with such requirements misting in terms, conditions, and form of the Bend and sureties the son as may be specified by such regulations.

(ii) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -- "

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding ilen. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section \$323(1), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
