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THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 1 (THE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE):

- 1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become demaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or claims for tien not expressify subordinated to the tien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedriess which may be secured by a tien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgages; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of (aw or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof, (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.
- Mortgagors shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to the Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor.
 To prevent default hereunder Mortgagors shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagors may desire to contest.
- 3. In the event of the enactment after (his date of any law of Illinois deducting from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any first increon, or imposing upon the Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or lies herein required to be paid by Mortgagors, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the holder thereof, then and in any such event, the Mortgagors, upon demand by the Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse the Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for the Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagors to make such payment or (b) the making of such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event, the Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to the Mortgagors, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (80) days from the giving of such notice.
- 4. If, by the laws of the United States of America or of any state having jurisdiction in the premises, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the noter are by secured, the Mortgagors covenant and agree to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. The Mortgagors further covenant to hold helicities and agree to indemnify the Mortgagee, and the Mortgagee's successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of ray tax on the issuance of the note secured hereby.
- 5. At such time as the Mirty gors are not in default either under the terms of the note secured hereby or under the terms of this mortgage, the Mortgagors shall have such primited, of making prepayments on the principal of said note (in addition to the required payments) as may be provided in said note.

All moneys prior for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys feas, and any other maneys advanced by Mortgages to protect the mortgage and the field hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without not be and with interest thereon at the highest rate now permitted by litinais law. Inaction of Mortgages shall now the considered as a waiver of any light accruing to the Mortgages on account of any eight accruing to the Mortgagors.
- 8. The Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to such six assessments, may do so according to any bill.
