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Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

if any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after deniand, the amount (including any interest additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the field inposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer afising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

S 6323. Validity and Priority

Against Certain Persons. (a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Medianic's Lieners, And Judgment Lieners, The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice the gol, which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been flight by the Secretary.

- (I) Place For Filing Notice: Form.—
- (1) Place For Filing .- The notice referred to in Subsection (a) shall be filed-
 - (A) Under State Laws --
 - (i) Real Property In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and
 - (ii) Personal Property. -- In the case of personal property, whether langible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, or
- (B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to the lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder OI Deeds OI The District of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

- (g) Refling Of Notice .- For purposes of this section-
- (1) General Rule,-Unless notice of fien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of hen shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such relaing period

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Reliase Di Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary chair issue a contilicate of release of any tien imposed with respect to any internal invenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which-
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed Together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully salisfied or has become legally unenforceable, or
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned imon the payment of the amount assessed together with all of rest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law pine sour, any extension of such time), and that is in accor dance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and to m of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations
