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## Notice of Claim for Receiver's Lien

Please take notice that the City of Chicago, a Municipal Corporation, has and claims a lien with the following described parcel of real estate pursuant to Chapter 24, Section 11-31-2, to wit:

The City of Chicago hereby reserves the right to amend this Lien from time to time to include additional fees and advances paid, together with costs and expenses in collection of such unpaid fees and advances.

Pursuant to Ill. Rev. Stat., ch. 120, § 752.1, the advances made by the City of Chicago to this property must be paid by a tax purchaser prior to obtaining a tax deed.


## ASSIGNMENT
