THIS MORTGAGE made as of January 4, 1989, by and between NBD Trust Company of Illinois, as Successor Trustee to NBD Highland Park Bank, N.A., formerly known as First National Bank of Highland Park duly authorized to accept and execute trusts in the State of Illinois, not personally, under the provisions of a deed or deeds in trust, duly recorded and delivered to said corporation in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated August 19, 1986, and known as Trust No. 4172-HP (The "Mortgagor), and NBD Highland Park Bank, N.A., a national banking association (the "Mortgagee").

WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS, Mortgagor has concurrently herewith executed and delivered a mortgage note bearing even date herewith (the "Note") in the principal sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.50), made payable to Mortgagee, in and by which Note Mortgagor promises to pay out of the assets of the trust estate held under the Trist Agreement the principal sum and interest thereon at the rate and in installments as provided in the Note. A copy of said Note is attached as Exhibit B. All of said principal and interest are made payable at such place as the holder or holders of the Note (the "Holders") may, from time to time, in writing appoint, and in absence of such appointment, then at the office of Mortgagee in Highland Park, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment of both principal and interest thereof, in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Note and in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this mortgage, and to secure the performance of the covenants and agreements herein and in the Note contained, to be performed by Mortgagor, does by these presents MORTGAGE, GRANT, REMISE, RELEASE, ALIEN and CONVEY unto Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the real estate described in Exhibit 3 attached hereto and made a part hereof and all of its estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the Lity of Chicago, County of Cook, and State of Illinois which, with the property hereinafter described, is referred to as the "premises,"

TOGETHER with all improvements, tenements, easements, fixtures, and appurtenances thereto pertaining or belonging, and all rents, issues and profits thereof for so long and during all such times as Mortgagor may be entitled thereto (which are pledged primarily and on a parity with said real estate and not secondarily), and including but not limited to all shades, awnings, venetian blinds, screens, screen doors, storm doors and windows, stoves and ranges, curtain fixtures, partitions, attached floor covering, now or hereafter therein or thereon

owned by Mortgagor and all fixtures, apparatus, equipment or articles now or hereafter therein or thereon used to supply heat, gas, air cooling, air conditioning, water, light, power, sanitation, sprinkler protection, waste removal, refrigeration (whether single units or centrally controlled), and ventilation, including (without restricting the foregoing), all other fixtures, apparatus, equipment, furniture, furnishings, and articles used or useful in connection with the operation of a building now or hereafter located upon said premises owned by Mortgagor, it being understood that the enumeration of any specific articles of property shall in nowise result in or be held to exclude any items of property not specifically mentioned. All of the land, estate and property hereinabove described, real, personal and mixed, whether affixed or annexed or not (except where otherwise hereinabove specified) and all rights hereby conveyed and mortgaged are intended so to be as a unit and are nereby understood, agreed and declared to form a part and parcel of the real estate and to be appropriated to the use of the real estate, and shall for the purpose of this mortgage be deemed to be real estate and conveyed and mortgaged hereby. As to any of the property aforesaid which (notwithstanding the aforesaid declaration and agreement) does not so form a part and parcel of the real estate, this mortgage is hereby deemed to be, as well, a Security Agreement under the Uniform Commercial Code for the purpose of creating hereby a security interest in such property, which Mortgagor hereby grants to Mortgagee as Secured Party (as said term is defined in the Uniform Commercial Code), socuring said indebtedness and obligations.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes and uses herein set forth.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED THAT:

Maintenance, Repair and Restoration of Improvements Payment of Prior Liens, Etc.

Mortgagor shall (a) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or hereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (b) keep the premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free of mechanics' liens or other liens or claims for lien not expressly subordinated to the lien hereof except that Mortgagor shall have the right to contest by appropriate proceedings diligently prosecuted the validity or amount of any such lien if and only if Mortgagor shall within fifteen (15) days after the filing thereof (1) place a bond with Mortgagee in an amount, form, content and issued by a surety reasonably acceptable to Mortgagee for the payment of any such lien or (2) cause the title company which has issued the loan policy of title

insurance to Mortgagee insuring the lien of this Mortgage to issue an endorsement thereto insuring against loss or damage on account of any such lien; (c) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises on a parity with or superior to the lien hereof and comply with all requirements of all loan documents evidencing or securing such indebtedness, and upon request, exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to Mortgagee; (d) complete within a reasonable time any building or buildings or any improvements now or at any time in the process of erection upon the premises; (e) comply, in all material respects, with all requirements of law, municipal ordinances, or restrictions of record with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (f) make no material alterations in the premises except as required by law or nunicipal ordinance, except with the prior written consent of Mortgagee, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld; (g) suffer or permit no change in the general nature of the occupancy of the premises, without Mortgagee's written consent, which consent will not be unreasonably withheld; (h) initiate or acquiesce in no zoning variation or reclassification, without Mortgagee's prior written consent; (i) pay each item of indebtodness secured by this mortgage when due according to the terms bereof or of the Note.

Payment of Taxes

2. Mortgagor shall pay before any penalty attaches all general taxes, and shall pay special taxes, special assessments, condominium assessments, water charges, sewer service charges, and other charges against the premises when due, and shall, upon written request, furnish to Mortgagee duplicate receipts therefor. To prevent default hereunder Kortgagor shall pay in full under protest, in the manner provided by statute, any tax or assessment which Mortgagor may desire to contest. If any special assessment is permitted by applicable law to be paid in installments, Mortgagor shall have the right to pay such assessment in installments, so long as all such installments are paid prior to the due date thereof. Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, Mortgagor shall have the right to protest any taxes assessed against the Premises, sollong as such protest is conducted in good faith by appropriate legal proceedings diligently prosecuted and Mortgagor shall furnish to the title insurer such security or indemnity as said insured requres to induce it to issue an endorsement, in form and substance acceptable to Mortgagee, insuring over any exception created by such protest.

Insurance

3. Mortgagor shall at all times keep all buildings, improvements, fixtures and articles of personal property now or hereafter situated on the Premises insured against loss or

damage by fire and such other hazards as may reasonably be required by Mortgagee, including without limitation: (a) all-risk fire and extended coverage insurance, with vandalism and malicious mischief endorsements, for the full replacement value of the Premises, with agreed upon amount and inflation quaid endorsements; (b) if there are tenants under leases at the Premises, rent and rental value or business loss insurance for the same perils described in (a) above payable at the rate per month and for the period specified from time to time by Mortgagee; (c) broad form boiler and sprinkler damage insurance in an amount reasonably satisfactory to Mortgage, if and so long as the Premises shall contain a boiler and sprinkler system, respectively; (d) if the Premises are located in a flood hazard district, flood insurance in the maximum amount obtainable up to the amount of the indebtedness hereby secured; and (e) such other insurance as Mortgagee may from time to time reasonably Mortgagor also shall at all times maintain comprehensive public liability, property damage and workmens' compensation insurance covering the Premises and any employees thereof, with such inits for personal injury, death and property damage as Mortgagee may reasonably require. policies of insurance to be furnished hereunder shall be in forms, companies, amounts and deductibles reasonably satisfactory to Mortgagee, with mortgagee clauses attached to all policies in favor of and in form satisfactory to Mortgagee, including a provision requiring that the coverage evidenced thereby shall not be terminated or materially modified without thirty (30) days' prior written notice to Mortgagee and shall contain endorsements that no act of negligence of the insured or any occupant and no occupancy or use of the Premises for purposes more hazardous than permitted by the terms of the policies will affect the validity or enforceability of such policies as against Mortgagee. Mortgagor snall deliver all policies, including additional and renewal policies, to Mortgagee, and, in the case of insurance about to expire, shall deliver renewal policies not less than thirty (37) days prior to their respective dates of expiration.

Mortgagor shall not take out separate insurance concurrent in form or contributing in the event of loss with that required to be maintained hereunder unless Mortgagee is included thereon under a standard mortgage clause acceptable to Mortgagee. Mortgagor immediately shall notify Mortgagee whenever any such separate insurance is taken out and promptly shall deliver to Mortgagee the policy or policies (or certificates thereof) of such insurance.

In the event of loss Mortgagor will give immediate notice by mail to Mortgagee, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgagor, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to Mortgagee instead of to Mortgagor and Mortgagee

jointly. Any insurance proceeds so received by Mortgagee, or any part thereof, shall be applied by Mortgagee, after the payment of all of Mortgagee's expenses, including costs and attorneys' fees, to the restoration or repair of the property damaged as provided in Paragraph 5 hereof. In the event of foreclosure of the Mortgage, all right, title and interest of Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser at the foreclosure sale. Mortgagor shall furnish Mortgagee, without cost to Mortgagee, at the request of Mortgagee, from time to time, evidence of the replacement value of the Premises.

Mortagee's Interest in and Use of Deposits

4. In the event of a default in any of the provisions contained in this mortgage or in the Note (after expiration of applicable grace periods, if any), Mortgagee may at its option, without being required to do so, apply any moneys at the time on deposit pursuant to any provision of this mortgage, as any one or more of the same may be applicable, on any of Mortgagor's obligations herein or in the Note contained, in such order and manner as Mortgagee may elect. When the indebtedness secured hereby has been fully raid, any remaining deposits shall be paid to Mortgagor or to the than owner or owners of the premises. Such deposits are hereby placed as additional security for the indebtedness hereunder and shall be held to be irrevocably applied by the depositary for the purposes for which made hereunder and shall not be subject to the direction or control of Mortgagor; provided, however, tout neither Mortgagee nor said depositary shall be liable for any failure to apply to the payment of taxes and assessments or insurance premiums any amount so deposited unless Mortgagor, while not in default hereunder, shall have requested said depositary in writing to make application of such funds to the payment of the particular taxes or assessments or the payment of the particular insurance premiums as the case may be for payment of which they were deposited, accompanied by the bills for such taxes and assessments or insurance premiums.

Adjustment of Losses with Insurer and Application of Proceeds of Insurance

5. In case of loss or damage by fire or other casualty, Mortgagor may settle and adjust any claim under insurance policies which insure against such risks so long as: (a) no insurer denies liability as to any insured or claims any right of participation in any of the Mortgagee's security; and (b) this Mortgage is not in default; then such insurance proceeds, after deducting therefrom any expenses incurred by Mortgagee in the collection thereof, shall be made available by the Mortgagee for the repair, rebuilding or restoration of the building(s) and other improvement(s) on the Premises. If Mortgagor is then in

default, Mortgagee is authorized to settle and adjust any claim and such insurance proceeds may, at the option of the Mortgagee, (a) applied in reduction of the Indebtedness, whether due or not; or (b) held by the Mortgagee and used to pay for the cost of the repair, rebuilding or restoration of the building(s) and other improvement(s) on the Premises. In the event of repair restoration or rebuilding, the building(s) and other improvement(s) shall be so repaired, restored or rebuilt so as to be of at least equal value and substantially the same character as prior to such damage or destruction. If the insurance proceeds are made available for repair, rebuilding or restoration, such proceeds shall be disbursed upon the "Disbursing Party" (hereinafter defined) being furnished with satisfactory evidence of the cost of completion thereof and with architects certificates, waivers of lien, contractors' and subcontractors' sworn statements, title continuations and other evidence of cost and payments so that the Disbursing Party can verify that the amounts disbursed from time to time are represented by completed and in-place work and that said work is free and clear of mechanics' lien claims. No payment made prior to the final completion of the work shall exceed ninety percent (90%) of the value of the work performed from time to time, and at all times the undisbursed balance of such proceeds remaining in the hands of the Disburging Party shall be at least sufficient to pay for the cost of completion of the work free and clear of liens. If the dost of rebuilding, repairing or restoring the buildings and other improvements may reasonably exceed the sum of FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00), then the Mortgagee must approve plans and specifications of such work before such work shall be commenced. Any surplus which may remain out of said insurance proceeds, after payment of the cost of repair, rebuilding, restoration and the reasonable charges of the Disbursing Party, shall, at the option of the Mortgagee, be applied on account of the Indebtedness or paid to any party entitled thereto as the same appear on the records of the Mortgagee. No interest shall be allowed to Mortgagor on any proceeds of insurance held by the Disbursing Party.

As used in this Paragraph 5, the term "Disburcing Party" refers to the Mortgagee and to any responsible trust company or title insurance company selected by the Mortgagee.

In case of loss after foreclosure proceedings have been instituted, the proceeds of any such insurance policy or policies, if not applied as aforesaid in rebuilding or restoring the buildings or improvements, shall be applied in payment or reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby or in payment or reduction of the amount due in accordance with any decree of foreclosure that may be entered in any such proceedings, and the balance, if any, shall be paid to the owner of the equity of redemption if it shall then be entitled to the same or as the court may direct. In case of the foreclosure of this mortgage,

the court in its decree may provide that the mortgagee's clause attached to each of said insurance policies may be cancelled and that the decree creditor may cause a new loss clause to be attached to each of said policies making the loss thereunder payable to said decree creditor; and any such foreclosure decree may further provide that in case of one or more redemptions under said decree, pursuant to the statute in such case made and provided, then and in every such case, each successive redemptor may cause the preceding loss clause attached to each insurance policy to be cancelled and a new loss clause to be attached thereto, making the loss thereunder payable to such redemptor. In the event of foreclosure sale, Mortgagee is hereby authorized, without the consent of Mortgagor, to assign any and all insurance policies to the purchaser at the sale, or to take such other steps as Mortgagee may deem advisable, to cause the interest of such purchaser to be protected by any of the said insurance policies.

Stamp_Tax

6. If, by the laws of the United States of America, or of any state having jurisdiction over Mortgagor, any tax is due or becomes due in respect of the issuance of the Note, or recording of this mortgage, Mortgagor covenants and agrees to pay such tax in the manner required by any such law. Mortgagor further covenants to hold harmless and agrees to indemnify Mortgagee, its successors or assigns, against any liability incurred by reason of the imposition of any car on the issuance of the Note, or recording of this mortgage.

Prepayment

7. At such time as Mortgagor is not in default either under the terms of the Note or under the terms or this mortgage, the Mortgagor shall have the privilege of making propayments on the principal of the Note in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Note.

Effect of Extensions of Time

8. If the payment of said indebtedness or any part thereof be extended or varied or if any part of the security be released, all persons now or at any time hereafter liable thereon, or interested in the premises, shall be held, to the extent permitted by law, to assent to such extension, variation or release, and their liability and the lien and all provisions hereof shall continue in full force, the right of recourse against all such persons being expressly reserved by Mortgagee, notwithstanding such extension, variation or release.

Effect of Changes in Laws Regarding Taxation

9. In the event of the enactment after this date of any law of the state in which the premises are located deducting

from the value of land for the purpose of taxation any lien thereon, or imposing upon Mortgagee the payment of the whole or any part of the taxes or assessments or charges or liens herein required to be paid by Mortgagor, or changing in any way the laws relating to the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgages or the mortgagee's interest in the property, or the manner of collection of taxes, so as to affect this mortgage or the debt secured hereby or the Holders, then, and in any such event, Mortgagor, upon demand by Mortgagee, shall pay such taxes or assessments, or reimburse Mortgagee therefor; provided, however, that if in the opinion of counsel for Mortgagee (a) it might be unlawful to require Mortgagor to make such payment or (b) the making such payment might result in the imposition of interest beyond the maximum amount permitted by law, then and in such event. Mortgagee may elect, by notice in writing given to Mortgagor, to declare all of the indebtedness secured hereby to be and become due and payable sixty (60) days from the giving of such notice.

Mortgagee's Performance of Defaulted Acts. Subrogation

In case of default herein (not cured within applicable cure period), Mortgages may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein of in any loan documents evidencing or securing the indebtedness secured hereby or any indebtedness secured by a prior encumbrance, required of Mortgagor, in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase discharge, compromise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting the premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including reasonable attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee to protect the premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall become immediately due and payable within 5 days after notice and with interest thereon at the post maturity rate. Inaction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right accruing to it on account of any default on the part of Mortgagor. Should the proceeds of the Note or any part thereof, or any amount paid out or advanced hereunder by Mortgagee, be used directly or indirectly to pay off, discharge or satisfy, in whole or in part, any lien or encumbrance upon the premises or any part thereof on a parity with or prior or superior to the lien hereof, then as additional security hereunder, the Mortgagee shall be subrogated to any and all rights, equal or superior titles, liens and equities, owned or claimed by any owner or holder of said outstanding liens, charges and indebtedness, however remote, regardless of whether said liens, charges and indebtedness are acquired by assignment or have been

released of record by the holder thereof upon payment. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained, in no event shall the indebtedness secured hereby exceed an amount equal to Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00).

Mortyagee's Reliance on Tax Bills, Etc.

11. Mortgagee in making any payment hereby authorized: (a) relating to taxes and assessments, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate procured from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, stacement or estimate or into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax lien or title or claim thereof, or (b) for the purchase, discharge, compromise or settlement of any other prior lien, may do so without inquiry as to the validity or amount of any claim for lien which may be asserted.

Acceleration of Indebtedness in Case of Default

12. If (a) default be made for ten (10) days in the due and punctual payment of the Note, or any installment due in accordance with the terms thereof, either of principal or interest; or (b) Mortgagor or any Affiliated Person shall file a petition in voluntary bankruptry or under any provision of the Federal Bankruptcy Code or any similar law, state or federal, whether now or hereafter existing, or an answer admitting insolvency or inability to pay its debts, or fail to obtain a vacation or stay of involuntary proceedings within sixty (60) days, as hereinafter provided; or (c) Mortgagor or any Affiliated Person shall be adjudicated a bankrupt, or a trustee or a receiver shall be appointed for Mortgagor or any Affiliated Person or for all of its property or the major part thereof in any involuntary proceeding for the reorganization, dissolution, liquidation or winding up of Mortgagor or any Affiliated Person, and such trustee or receiver shall not be discharged or such jurisdiction relinquished or vacated or stayed on appeal or otherwise stayed within sixty (60) days; or (d) Mortjayor or any Affiliated Person shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or shall admit in writing its inability to gay its debts generally as they become due, or shall consent to the appointment of a receiver or trustee or liquidator of all of its property or the major part thereof; or (e) Mortgagee shall have the right to declare the indebtedness secured hereby due and payable pursuant to paragraph 33 hereof; or (f) default in any other indebtedness secured by a mortgage of these premises, or a default; or (g) default shall be made in the due observance or performance of any other of the covenants, agreements or conditions hereinbefore or hereinafter contained, required to be kept or performed or observed by Mortgagor or any Affiliated Person and the same shall continue for thirty (30) days after notice, then and in every such case the whole of said principal sum hereby secured shall, at once, at the option of Mortgagee, become immediately due and payable, together with accrued

interest thereon, without further notice to Mortgagor. In the event that any default specified by Mortgagee to Mortgagor under "(g)" above shall be of such nature that it cannot be cured or remedied within 30 days, Mortgagor shall be entitled to a reasonable period of time to cure or remedy such default, provided Mortgagor commences the cure or remedy thereof within the 30 day period following the giving of such notice and thereafter proceeds with diligence to complete such cure or remedy.

Foreglosure: Expense of Litigation

13. When the indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof shall become due, whether by acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee shall have the right to foreclose the lien hereof for such indebtedness or part thereof.

In any suit to foreclose the lien hereof or to enforce any other remedy of Mortgagee under this mortgage or the Note, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sile or other judgment or decree all expenditures and expenses which may be paid or incurred by or on behalf of Mortgagee for reasonable attorneys' fees, appraiser's fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs, and costs (which may be estimated as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such costracts of title, title searches and examinations, title insurance policies, Torrens certificates, and similar data and assurances with respect to title and value as Mortgagee may deem reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title to or the value of the premises. All expenditures and expenses of the nature in this Section mentioned, and such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the protection of the premises and the maintenance of the lien of this martyage, including the fees of any attorney employed by Mortgagee in any litigation or proceeding affecting this mortgage, the Note or the premises, including probate and bankruptcy proceedings, or in preparations for the commencement or defense of any proceeding or threatened suit or proceeding, shall be immediately due and payable by Mortgagor, with interest thereon at the post maturity rate and shall be secured by this mortgage.

Application of Proceeds of Foreclosure Sale

14. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority: First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding Section hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and

interest remaining unpaid on the Note; fourth, any overplus to Mortgagor, its successors or assigns, as their rights may appear.

Appointment of Receiver

Upon, or at any time after the filing of a complaint to foreclose this mortgage, the court in which such complaint is filed may appoint a receiver of the premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mortgagor at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestead or not and Mortgagee hereunder or any Holders may be appointed as such receiver.
