- 2. On January 23, 1989, Defendants filed in the Court of Common Pleas of Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania, a Notice of Appeal of the judgment entered against them on December 20, 1988.
- 3. The judgment against Defendants is in the amount of \$390,637.34 plus interest, as more fully set forth in Exhibit A.
