

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, or with any costs that may accrue in addition thereta) shall be a lien in fever of the United States upon all property and rights to preparty, whether real or personal, belonging

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien inspeced by section \$321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment spathol the taxpayer arising out of such liability) to satisfied or becames unenforceable by reason of lance of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

## m Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other gover subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the graperty subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one affice within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(8) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Doods Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Goods of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the ken is situated in the District of Columbia
