That the recommendation of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Chicago, 910- viding for said improvement, together with the estimate of the cost better, including the lawful expenses attending the same, made by the engineer of said Board both hereto attached, he and the same are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That said improvement shall be made and the cost thereof, including the lawful expenses attending the same, be paid by special assessment in accordance with an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled, "An Act Concerning Local Improvements," approved June 14th, A. SECTION 3. That the aggregate amount helein ordered to be assessed against the property, and also the assessment on each lot and parcel of land therein assessed shall be divided into five (5) installments in the manner provided by the statute in such case, made and provided, and each of said installments shall bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per centum per innum according to law until paid, or as otherwise provided by law.

SECTION 4. That for the purpose of anticipating the collection of the second and succeeding installments of said agreement for said improvement (except such part, if any that is chargeable to the City of Chicago for public benefits to public lands), bonds shall be issued payable out of said installments bearing interest at the rate of seven (7) per centum per annum, or as otherwise provided by law, payable annually, and signed by the Mayor and by the President of the Board of Local improvement, countersigned by the City Competaller and attested by the City Clerk under the corporate seal of the City of Chicago, Said bunds shall be issued in accordance with and shall in all respects conform to the provision of the Act of the General Assembly of the State of Illinois, entitled, "An Act Concerning Local improvements", approved June 19th, A.D. 1897, and the amendments thereto.

SECTION 5. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby directed to file a petition in the Circuit Court of Cook County. Illinois, in the name of the City of Chicago, praying that steps may be taken to levy a special ansessment for said improvement in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance and in the manner prescribed by law.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances, or pure of ordinances, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage.
