

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cour

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interact, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty.

- gether with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person
- Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of uch liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inerests; Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Craditors. — The Nen imposed by section \$321 shall not be told as against any purchaser, holder of a security chanic's lienar, or judgment lien creditar until notice thereof guitch meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary

(n Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

- (1) Place For Filing The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -
 - (A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governments) subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject is the lien is situated.

(R) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A) or

(C) With Recorder Or Deeds Of The District Of Columbia In the affice of the Recorder of Doods of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property. aner tengible or intengible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed

For purpose of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partiers in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal exicutive Alice of the business is located, and the residence of a triving or whose residence is without the United States shall be der ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such netice shall by valid notwithstanding any other provision of law requirer, the form or content of a natice of lies.
