In no event over the full term of the Note will the interest rate be increased more than Three and 1/Percentage points (3.5 %) from the Initial Rate of Interest.

Before each Change Date the Note Holder will calculate the new interest rate by adding three and 1/2 percentage points (3.5 %) to the Current Latex. However, the rate of interest that is required to be paid shall never be increased or decreased on any single Change Date by more than Two percentage points (2 %) from the rate of interest currently being said.
