Excerpts From Internal Revenue Coffs

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax reglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any inter-L additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, er with any costs that may accrue in addition therefol shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, weather real or personal, belonging to auch parado.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

m Place For Filling Notice: Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such Blate, in which the property aubject to the lien is altusted; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of each State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of ragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be oftuated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, ther tangible or intangible, at the residence of the saxpa or at the time the notice of ilen is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation arth irship shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal exe with a writer of the business is fecused, and the residence of Light area whose residence is without the United States shall be duer and to be in the District of Columbia.

- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of Herrie refiled in the manner prescribed in paregraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the data orrwhich it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the application of such refiling period.

 - (i) such notice of lien is ratifed in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by aubsection (f) (4), and
 - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of neptoe of tien under subparagraph (A), the

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall lasue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Asturns and Return Information.

(in Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lies. - If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
