## Excerpts From Internal Revenus Cron

Sec. 6321, Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, segment with any costs that may accrue in addition therete) shall be a lien fever of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such seriors.

Sec. 6322, Period 01 Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the item imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the aspessment is made and shall continue until the itability for the amount so seesped (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against
Certain Persons.

(a) Princhager's, Holders Of Security interests' Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Califors. — The ten imposed by section \$221 shall not be well as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest freshanic's tiener, or judgment (len craditor until notice thereof article meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been thighty the Secretary.

## (n) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filled -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the Hen is alturated; and

(II) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangele or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State. In which the property subject to the lien is altusted;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - in the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subpersonable IA. by

(C) With Hecorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the effice of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Just is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Since Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, proviner tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpt yer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

(2) Form. The orm and centant of the notice reterned to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice says b valid notwithstanding any other provision of tax regardless the form or content of a notice of than.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section-
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of item is settled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such motion of item shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subscriber (9)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of item refitted during the required staffing period shall be effective only (A) if
  - (i) such notice of lien is rethed in the office in which the prior notice of tien was filed, and
  - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (it) (4), and
  - (B) in any case in which, 60 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of hen under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the finantial prescribed in regulations leased by the Secretary) concerning a change in the texpeyor's residence, if a notice of such lies it also filed in accordance with sebsection (f) to the State in which such residence is technol.

(3) Required Refling Period. — In the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the taxx, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of Sysers after the close of the praceding required refling period for such notice of then.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.
