between the Mortgagor, Kevin T. O'Doherty and Michele T. O'Doherty, His Wife (herein "Borrower"),

and the Mortgagee, AVONDALE FEDERAL SAVINGS BANK, a federally chartered savings bank, whose address is 20 North Clark Street, Chicago, Illinois 60602 (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of (\$ 285,000.00 ("Maximum Amount"), or so much of that sum as may be advanced pursuant to the obligation of Lender (whichever is lesser), and evidenced by Borrower's Note, providing for monthly payments of principal and/or interest and, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sponer paid, due and payable on ______May 15, 1994 the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on____ ("Maturity Date") unless extended pursuant to paragraph 22 hereof.

TO SECURE to Lender the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note (including, but not limited to, such obligator, friture advances ("Future Advances") as are described in paragraph 18 hereof), the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of the Borrower herein contained, Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Loder the property legally described

in the attached Exhibit "A" orated in the County of_ Cook ____, State of Illinois, which has the address of 250 Otis Rd., Barrington Hills, Illinois 60010 ("Property Address").

TOGETHER with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water, water rights and water stock, and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to the property, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto, shall be deemed to be and remain part of the property covered by this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing, together with said property (or the leasehold estate if this i fortgage is on a leasehold) are herein referred to as "Property".

Borrower covenants that Borrower is nawfully selsed of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, that the Property is unencumbered with the exception of those items, if any, listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lender's interest in the Property, and that Borrower will warrant and defend se nerally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any encumbrances, declarations, easements or restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lende 's interest in the Property.

Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. Payment of Principal and Interest. Borrower shall properly pay when due without set-off, recoupment, or deduction, the principal of and the interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, and late charges as provided in the Note, including the principal of and interest on any Future A wances secured by this Mortgage.
- 2. Application of Payments. All payments received by Lender under the Note and paragraph 1 hereof, shall be applied by Lender first in payment of interest due on the Note, tien to principal of the Note, including any amounts considered as added thereto under the terms hereof.
- 3. Charges; Liens, Borrower shall promptly pay all obligations secured by a mortgage or trust deed affecting the Property, taxes, assessments and other charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain a priority over this Mortgage, and leasehold payments or ground rents, if any, when due. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts due under this paragraph, and in the event Borrower shall make payment directly, Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing such payments. Borrower shall promptly discharge any lien which has priority over this Mortgage with respect to any sum, ir cluding, but not limited to, Future Advances.
- 4. Hazard Insurance. Borrower shall keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the Property insured against loss by fire, hazards included within the term "extended coverage", and such other hazards as Lender may require and in such amounts and for such periods as Lender may require; provided, think ender shall not require that the amount of such coverage exceed that amount of coverage required to pay the sums secured by this Mortgage and all other mortgages and trust deeds with respect to the Property.

The insurance carrier providing the insurance shall be chosen by Borrower subject to approval by Lender; provided, that such approval shall not be unreasonably withheld. All premiums on insurance policies shall be paid by Borrower when due.

All insurance policies and renewals thereof shall be in form acceptable to Lender and shall include a standard mortgage clause in favor of and in form acceptable to Lender. Lender shall have the right to hold the policies and renewals thereof, and Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all renewal notices and all receipts of paid premiums. In the event of loss, Borrower shall give prompt notice to the insurance carrier and Lender. Lender may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Borrower.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, insurance proceeds shall be applied to restoration or repair of the Property damaged, provided such restoration or repair is economically feasible or if the security of this Mortgage would be impaired, the insurance proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Mortgage, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower. If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if Borrower falls to respond to Lender within 30 days from the date notice is mailed by Lender to Borrower that the insurance carrier offers to settle a claim for insurance benefits, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the insurance proceeds at Lender's option either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Mortgage.

Unless Lender and Borrower otherwise agree in writing, any such application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly installments referred to in paragraph 1 hereof or change the amount of such installments.
