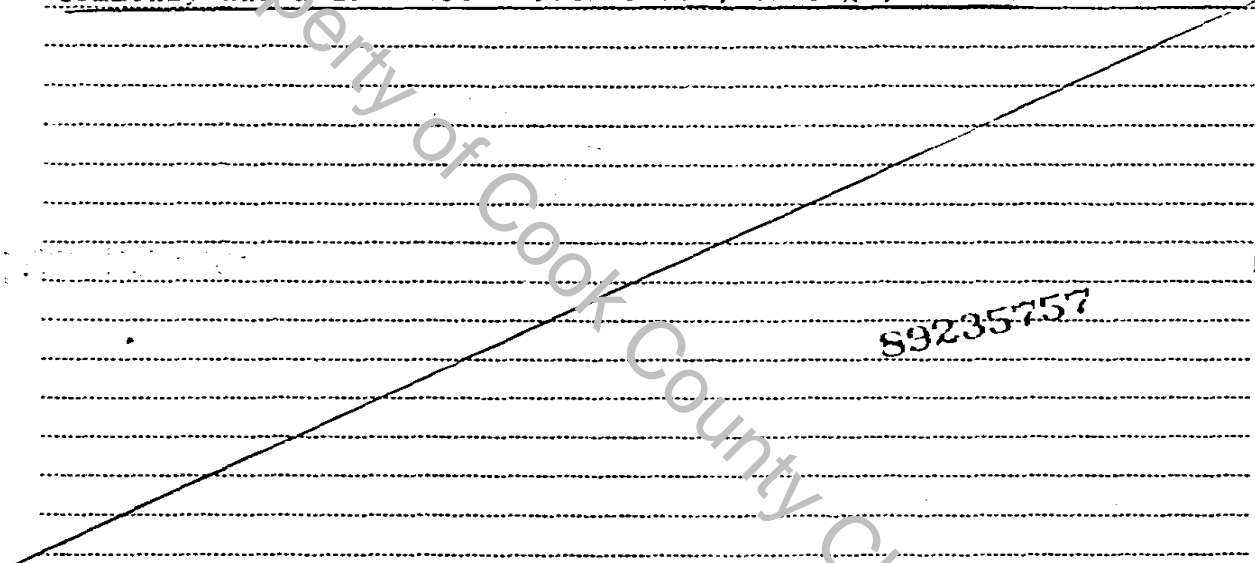

If the holder of such Certificate shall be prevented from obtaining such Deed by injunction or order of any Court, or by refusal of the Clerk to execute the same, the time he is so prevented shall be excluded from the computation of such time."
