THE DEFENDANT IS CONVICTED OF THE OFFENSE(S) OF: Knowingly, wilfully and unlawfully making a false claim for benefits under the Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act;

In violation of Title 45, United States Code, Section 359, as charged in counts 1 and 2 of the information.

IT IS THE JUDGMENT OF THIS COURT THAT: The defendant is placed on probation for a period of TWO (2) YEARS on counts 1 and 2, to run concurrently, on condition that he make restitution to the Railroad Retirement Board in the amount of \$1,612.98, that he pay the administrative fine ordered by said board, and that he undergo drug use evaluation and if needed, treatment.

In addition to any conditions of probation imposed above, IT IS ORDERED that the conditions of probation set out on the reverse of this judgment are imposed.

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## CONDITIONS OF PROBATION

Where probation has been ordered the defendant shall:

- (1) refrain from violation of any law (federal, state, and local) and get in touch immediately with your probation officer if arrested or questioned by a law-enforcement officer;
- (2) associate only with law-abiding persons and maintain reasonable hours;
- (3) work regularly at a lawful occupation and support your legal dependents, if any, to the best of your ability. (When out of work notify your probation officer at once, and consult him prior to job changes);
- (4) not leave the judicial district without permission of the probation officer;
- (5) notify your probation officer immediately of any changes in your place of residence;
- (6) follow the probation officer's instructions and report as directed.

The court may change the conditions of probation, reduce or extend the period of probation, and at any time during the probation period or within the maximum probation period of 5 years permitted by law, may issue a warrant and revoke probation for a violation occurring during the probation period.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall pay a total special assessment of \$ 25.00 pursuant to Title 18, U.S.C. Section 3013 for count(s) two as follows:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT ~~counts~~ THE ORIGINAL INDICTMENT IS ~~be~~ DISMISSED on the motion of the United States.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall pay to the United States attorney for this district any amount imposed as a fine, restitution or special assessment. The defendant shall pay to the clerk of the court any amount imposed as a cost of prosecution. Until all fines, restitution, special assessments and costs are fully paid, the defendant shall immediately notify the United States attorney for this district of any change in name and address.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of the court deliver a certified copy of this judgment to the United States marshal of this district.
