Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cras

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, bulonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment. is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasers, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors,—The lian imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, methanic's liener, or judgment tien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary.

NOTE: See section 6323(b) for protection for cartain interests even though natice of lian imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- (1) Place For Filing Notice: Form.—
  (1) Place For Filing.—The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed-
  - (A) Under State Laws.
  - (i) Real Property. -- In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and
  - (ii) Personal Property. In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clark Of District Court-In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to the lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subperagraph (A), or

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(C) With Recorder OI Deeds Of The District of Columbia. -- In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien. -- For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be sit ated-

(A) Real Property. -In the case of real property, at its physical location; or ...

- (B) Parama Property. In the case of personal property, whither targible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at visitime the notice of lien is filed. For purposes of paragraph (2)(B), the residence of a corporation or partnership thail by deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located. and the residence of a taxpaye why se residence is without the United States shall be deemediful be in the District of Columbia
- (3) Form. -The form and content of the make referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any of or provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.
  - (g) Refling Of Netice. For purposes of this section
- (1) Seneral Rulu.-Unless notice of lien is relited in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliting period, such notice of ken shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (1) after the expiration of such reliting period.

(2) Place For Filing,—A notice of lien retited during the required rafilling period shall be effective only-

(i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which

the prior notice of lien was filed, and
(iii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (i) (41; and

(B) 'In any case in which 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, it a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (I) in the State in which such residence is located.

red Reliling Period.—In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required retiling period" means-

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the

(B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required reliling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien.—Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue'a certificate of release of any flen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which-

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. -- The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become logally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted.—There is turnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law including any extension of such time), and that is in accor-Cance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions. and firm of the bond and sureties thereon, as may be specified by such regulations

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, -- If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may, be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such Hen or intends to obtain a right in such property.



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
