

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to: pay 11/a same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition theracol shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lies imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Hability for the amount so accessed (or a judgment against the taxpeyer arising out of such Ketility) is actisfied or becomes unenforceable by resean of lance of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The iten imposed by section \$121 shall not be valle as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's ligner, or judgment tion creditor until notice thereo! which spects the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n) Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-(a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other govern subdivision), as assignated by the leave of such State. In which the property subject to the lies is attraced; and

(4) Parsent Property - in the case of personal property, whether tamplole or intampitie, in one office within the State (or the county, or other government subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is altuated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law deelenated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(a) Reffling Of Notice. — For purposes of this

(1) General Rule. — Unless notice of Herr is refitted in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reftling parted, such notice of lien shall be treeted as filed on the date orrwhich it is filed (in accordance with subsection (fi) after the expiration of such refiling paried.

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of iten refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only.

(2) Regulred Refilling Period. -- in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refilling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years piter the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property. 6325. Sec.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(I) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully suitafied or has
