

Excerpts From internal Revenue Cod

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any lax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any posts that may accrue in addition thesits) shall be aller in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether rest or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322, Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the field imposed by section 6325 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer artsing out of such fiability) is estimated or becomes unentercoable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchasat's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The iten imposed by section 62:1 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

(i) Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in sub-section (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the preparty subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the Her is situated;

(8) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the cieck of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is altusted, whenever the State has not by less designated one office which meets the requirements of subpersgraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the key is situated in the District of Columbia. - (g) **Wefiling Of Notice.** For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule, Unless notice of lien is rathed in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with superction (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filling. A notice of lien reflied during the required refitting period shall be effective only. (A) if.
 - (i) such notice of lien is reffled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
 - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of tion under subparagraph (A). the

Secretary received entities information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a netice of such tien is also filled in accordance with subsection (f) is the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Retiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the rere "required retiling period" means - (A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 4 years after the close of the preceding required retiling period for exchingtion of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Becretary may prescribe. He Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unerturceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the emount passessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has hecome legally unaniorceable; or
- (2) Bend Accepted.
