

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person Hable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, at assessable penalty, together with any costs that may apove in addition therstep shall be a iten in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether read or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date in specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall conflue until the liability for the amount of successed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such Hability) is autisfied or becomes smenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(e) Purchaser's, Holdern Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The Hen imposed by section \$321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's Henor, or judgment lien creditor until holice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(f) Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

ewel state take (A)

(i) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is alfuelted; and

(iii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in sme office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the tawn of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is altuated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the liest is situated in the District of Columbia. (2) Situs Of Property Bublect To Lies - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated - (A) Refat Property - in the case of jest property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, who her tangible or intengible, at the residence of the tangever at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For purpose a of persentable (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or particle stop shall be deemed to be the place at which she principal a secretary office of the business is located, and the realdence of a training purpose residence is without the United States shall be downed to in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice reterred to in subsection following following the prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice a sall be valid netwithstanding any other provision of law regards, the form or content of a notice of lion.

- (g) Refiling Of Hotics. For purposes of this section:
- (!) General Rule, Unless notice of lien is reflect in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the assistation of such refilling period.
- (2) Place For Filting. A notice of item refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is antered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of see under subparagraph (A). We

(3) Required Retting Period. — in the case of any notice of len, the term "required refilling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the fax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required critting period for such notice of lies.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(s) Release Of Light. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any liten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which:

(1) Liability Satisfied or Linenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount sessessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted. There is inmished to the Secretary and a to pied by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereo, with in the time prescribed by law (including any extension of the him), and that is necondarios with such requirements of laws to series, conditions, and form of the bond and purpose thereo, as may be specified by each regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(b) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of autotanding tien. - If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the autotanding obligation secured by such tien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes unitefactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such tien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
