

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition theraty, shall be a lien in favor of the united States upon all property and rights to property, whether read or personal, belonging to such persons.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the Sen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is actisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's flenor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filled by the Secretary.

## (1) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Heal Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lies is altuated; and

(ii) Parsonal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible; in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is altusted;

(B) With Clerk Of District Court - In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparacraph (A).

(C) With Recorder Di Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - in the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

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[2] Situs Of Property Subject To Llen - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated - (A) Razi Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whicher tampible or intangible, at the residence of the tempoyer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (5) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice a lab be valid notwithstanding any order provision of law regarding the form or coment of a notice of lies.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filled with respect to:

(a) Refilling Of Notice. - For purposes of this section -

(1) General Risle. — Unless notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (1)) after the expiration of such refiling period.

(2) Place For Filling. — A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only -

(A) H -

 (i) such notice of lien is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of item under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) is the State in which such residence is accessed.

(3) Required Refilling Period. — In the case of any notice of (ien, the term "required refilling period" means(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of line.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and a copted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereor, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of crush time), and that is in accordance with such requirement, refusing to terms, conditions, and form of the boost and sureties there on, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding iten. - If a notice of iten has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
