Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cour

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs, that may accrue in addition therein shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the flen imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lanse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.— The Han imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

in Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice rafarred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(f) Real Property - in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the ilen is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court - In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, wherever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Slen is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated (A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, angular tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tangayer at the time the notice of lien is filled.

For pulph set of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partitives in shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal ax cutile of the business is located, and the residence of a sampler whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and contant of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notwithstanding any profession of law regarding the form or content of a notice of tien.

Note: See section 6323(b) for protection for certain interests even though source of lien imposed by section 6321 is filled with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- 2. Motor yehicles
- 3. Personal property purchased at retail
- 4. Personal property purchased in casual sale
- Personal property subjected to possessory lien
 Real property tax and special assessment items
- Residential property subject to a mechanic's lien for certain repairs and improvements

- 10. Pasabook loans
- (g) Reffling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of tien is reflied in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filed on the date orrwhich it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) **Place For Filing.** A notice of lien refiled during the required refilling period shall be effective only (A) If -

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refliring of notice of lien under subgaragraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located:

(3) Required Refiling Period. — In the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lieft. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tux not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Sutisfied or Unerspreade - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, logsther with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unerspreaded or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and not by land bond that is conditioned upon the payment of that amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof with the time prescribed by law (including any extension of architecturing), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereof, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. —

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien; -'it's notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section £323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
