Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth in the Instrument, Mortgagee and Mortgagor hereby acknowledges and agrees to the following.

GUARANTY: Should the Veteracs Administration fail or refuse to issue its guaranty in full amount within 60 days from the date that this loan would normally become eligible for such guaranty committed upon by the Veterans Administration under the provisions of Title 38 of the U.S. Code "Veterans Benefits", the Mortgagee may declare the indebtedness hereby secured at or ce due and payable and may foreclose immediately or may exercise any other rights hereunder or take any other proper action as by law provided.

TRANSFER OF THE PROPERTY: If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred, this loan shall be immediately due and payable or cransfer ("assumption") of the property securing such loan to any transferee ("assumer"), unless the acceptability of the assumption and transfer of this loan is established by the Veterans Administration or its authorized agent pursuant to section 1817A of Chapter 37, Title 38, United States Code.
