

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Co'le

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereta, shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and right to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

- * /* Unless another data is specifically fixed by law, the ilen-imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the essessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so essessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied at becomes unenforceable by reason of lease of time.
 - Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.
 - (a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Riechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The Ion Imposed by section \$821 shalt not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's liener, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

- (g) Refling Of Notice. -- For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of Hen is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refiling period, such notice of Hen shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (1)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. A notice of iten reflied during the required refiling period shall be effective only -
 - (f) such notice of lien is raffled in the office in which the prior notice of flen was filed, and

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Liert. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unanforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully estisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted. There is furnished to the Secretary and supposed by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respectitions, within the time prescribed by law (including any extensions) and the time, and that is in accordance with each requirement in using to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and suretise are an as may be specified by such regulations.
