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

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Cody

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may account to activition thereto) shall be a lief to favor of the United States upon all property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322: Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the iten imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the Rability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of assessed to a substitute or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lieners, And Judgment Lien Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 621 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest mechanic's liener, or judgment then creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(n) Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (e) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental) subdivisión); as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(U) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intengible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated;

(B) With Clark Of District Court: In the affice of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds of the District Of Columbia - In the office of this Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia; if the property subject to the Tag is situated in the District of Columbia.

(2) Shull Of Property Subject To Uen - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(a) Relilling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

- (1) General Rule. Unioss notice of tien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date or which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.
- (2) **Place For Filing.** A notice of lien refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only (A) II -

(i) such notice of lien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) In the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the dete of a refiling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary received written information fin the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpeyor's residence. (3) Required Refiling Period. — in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refiling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any intermal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.
- (1) Uability Satistied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has been fully sa
- (2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and (icc pied by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amplian assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of small line), and that is in accordance with such requirements (at time) to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelies there so we may be appelled by such regulations.

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

- (t) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return information For Tax Administration Purposes.—
- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding field.—If a notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section \$323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who turnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
