

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes.

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accuse in addition thereto) shall be a lien in javor of the United States upon all property and rights to property; whicher real or personal, belonging to such person.

tiniess another data is appointably fixed by law, the iten imposed by section 5321 shall arise at the time the assessment is reade and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment apainst the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Inserests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Liet Creditors. — The lien imposed by section 8521 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security intensit, mechanic's items, or judgment lien creditor until notice therest which meets the requirements of subsection (i) has been filed by the Secretary.

(1) Place For Filling Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subection (s) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental; subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, whether tangible or imangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the item is situated;

(B) With Clerk of District Court in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to tien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(c) With Recorder Di Deeds Of The District Of Columbia - In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the Rep. is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be allusted-(A) Real Property - in the case of real property, at its

physical location; or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property, who her tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxosyer at the time the notice of lies is filed.

For pur ose t of paragraph (2) (9), the residence of a corporation of particularly chall be deemed to be the place at which the principal a equiviry office of the business is located, and the residence of a time regard whose residence is without the United States shall be deemed to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice at all 18 valid notwithstanding any other provision of few regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

(1) General Risle. — Unless notice of fients rafiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) Juning the required rafiling period, such notice of fian shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such rafiling period.

(2) Place For Filing. — A notice of lien reflied during the required refiling period shall be effective only.

(i) such notice of iten is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of iten was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refilling of notice of then under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the Manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such tion is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is tocated:

(3) Required Reliting Period. — In the case of any notice of lies, the zerra "required refilling period" means—
(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the dark of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending whit the expiration of 8 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of ties.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shell issue a certificate of release of any iten imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has

become legally unenforceable; or

become legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted - There is furnished to the Secretary and
all the legal bond that is conditioned upon the payment of
the smooth assessed, together with all interest in respect
thereof within the time prescribed by law (including any
extension of left time), and that is in accordance with such

Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return information.

(d Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding tien. It is notice of tien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
