ORDINANCE NO. 0-88-90

AN ORDINANCE
ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF PALATINE
623, 629, AND 631 S. PLUM GROVE ROAD

WHEREAS, the Owners of record of the following described territory have petitioned that said territory be annexed to the Village of Palatine, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Authorities find and have determined that said territory is contiguous to the Village of Palatine; and

WHEREAS, the Palatine Rural Fire Protection District has been duly notified in writing more than ten (10) days in advance of consideration of this ordinance, pursuant to statutes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Palatine, acting in the exercise of their home rule power:

SECTION 1: That the following territory:

Lots 2, 3 and 4 in Block 2 in Arthur T. McIntosh and Company's Palatine Estates Unit No. 1, a subdivision of the S.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 22 and the S.W. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 23, Township 42 North Range 10, East of the Third Principal Meridian, recorded on July 2, 1926 as Document No. 9328053, all in Cook County, Illinois.

commonly known as 623, 629 and 631 South Plum Grove Road

and as shown on the plat of annexation attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Palatine.

That upon passage of this ordinance, a copy hereof, including the plat as certified as correct by the Village Clerk, be filed with the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois in accordance with Illinois Revised Statutes, Ch. 24, Article VII.

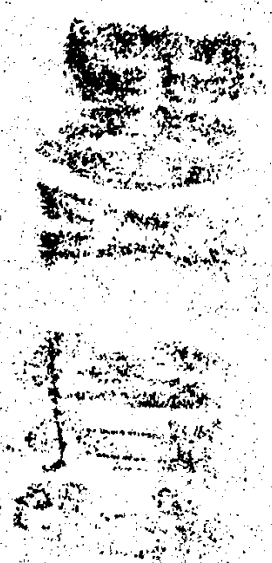
