2. DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Illinois Ur form Commercial Code.

Borrower. The word "Borrower" means each and every person who signs the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement secured by this Mortgage.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated 8/14/90 between Lender and Grantor with a credit limit of the amount show on the first page of this Socialty Instrument, together with all renewals of, extensions of, modifications of, refinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The graduity date of this Mortgage, which is the date by which all indebtedness under the Credit Agreement and this Mortgage is due is 8/14/2005. The interest rate under the revolving line of credit is a variable interest rate based upon an inclex. The index currently is 10.0 % per annum. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, which obligates Lender to make advances to Grantor so long as Grantor compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding belance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such belance at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. Therefore, the lien of this Mortgage will remain in full force and effect notwithstanding any zero balance.

Lease. The word "Lease" means any lease between Grantor and the Lessor of the Property.

Lender. The word "Lender" means BAE: Credit Union, its successors or assigns. The Lender is the mortgaged under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender.

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Personal Property: " words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property now or hereafter owned by Grantor, and now or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, (ny of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of premiums) from any sale or office disposition of the Property.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all rents, revenues, income, issues, royallies, and profits from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, AND, IF ANY, A SECURITY INTERES IN THE PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

- 3. PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lender all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under the LOANLINERS Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement and under this Mortgage.
- 4. POSSESSION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Use. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promotily perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. Grantor represents and warrants that the Property never has been, and power will be so long as this Mortgage remains a lien on the Property, used for the generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or intralened release of any hazardous waste or substance, as those terms are defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et seq. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act ("SARA"), applicable state or Federal laws, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Grantor authorizes Lender and its agents to other upon the Property to make such inspections and lests as Lender may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for indemnity or contribution in the event Grantor becomes liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnity and hold harmless Lender against any and all claims and or as resulting from a breach of the paragraph of the Mortgage. This obligation to indemnity shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction of this Mortgage.

Nulsance, Waste. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or suffer any stripping of waste on or to the Property or any portion of the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any ilmber, minerals (including oil and gas), still, gravet or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Reat Property at all reasonable times to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good faith any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lender in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's Interests in the Property are not jeopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surely bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

- 5. COMPLIANCE WITH LEASE. If there is a Lease on the Property, Grantor will pay all rents and will strictly observe and perform on a timely basis all other terms, covenants, and conditions of the Lease. Grantor further agrees: (a) not to surrender, terminate, or cancel the Lease, and: (b) not to mudify, change, supplement, after, or amend the Lease, either orally or in writing, without Lender's prior written consent. No estate in the Property, whether fee title to the leasehold premises, the leasehold estate, or any subleasehold estate, will merge without Lender's express written consent; rather these estates will remain separate and distinct, even if there is a union of these estates in the landford, Grantor, or a third party who purchases or otherwise acquires the estates. Grantor further agrees that if Grantor acquires all or a portion of the fee simple title, or any other leasehold or subleasehold title to the Property, that title will, at Lender's option, immediately become subject to the terms of this Mortgage, and Grantor will execute, deliver and record all documents necessary or appropriate to assure that such title is secured by this Mortgage.
- 4. REHABILITATION LOAN AGREEMENT. Grantor shall fulfill all of Grantor's obligations under any home rehabilitation, improvement, repair, or other

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loan agreement which Grantor may enter into with Lender. Lander, at Lender's option, may require Grantor to execute and deliver to Lender, in a form acceptable to Lender, an assignment of any rights, claims or defenses which Grantor may have against parties who supply latios, materials or service in connection with improvements made to the Property.

- 7. DUE ON SALE CONSENT BY LENDER. Unider may, at its option, have the right to accelerate, that is declare remediately due and payable as sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent of the rear part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. If Grantor solls or transfers the Real Property without the written consent of Lender, then, prior to acceleration Lander shall give notice to Grantor. The notice shall provide a period of not less than ten (10) days from the date of the related within which Grantor may pay the sums declared due. He waver, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.
- 8. TRANSFER OF PROPERTY. The following provisions relating to the transfer of the Real Property are a part of this Mortgage:

Notice of Transfer. Grantor shall give notice to Lunder, as provided in this Mortgage, prior to any sale or transfer of all or part of the Property or any rights in the Beat Property. Any person to whom all or part of the Beat Property is sold or transferred also shall be obligated to give notice to Lender, as provided in this Mortgage, promptly after such transfer.

Advances After Fransfer. All amounts advanced under the I CANTINER® Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement, up to the Credit Limit, are secured by this Mc(tgrige, whether advanced before or after sale or transfer of the Real Property, except any amounts which may be advanced by Lender more than two (5) days after notice to Lender, as provided in this Mortgage, that such transfer or sale has occurred. Even if Grantor transfers the Real Property Grantor will continue to be obligated under the Credit Agreement and this Mortgage unless Lander releases Grantor in writing. As a condition to Cerater's consent to any proposed transfer or as a condition to the release of Grantor, Lender may require that the person to whom the Real Property is transferred sign an assumption agreement satisfactory to Lender and Lender may impose an assumption fee. The assumption agreement wilk not satisfactors advances under the Credit Agreement.

9. TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes at 1 liens on the Properly are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to calinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, special taxes, assessments, water charges and saver service charges levied against rir on account of the P operty, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall main ain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of laxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragrap in

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any lax, assument, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeoperated. If a lien arises or is filled as a rusult of nonpayment, Grantor shall within lifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filled, within lifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filling, secure the discharge of the lien, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient or police surely bond or other security satisfactory to Londer in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and afterneys' fees or other or arges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sate under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy 2 by adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Lender satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Lender at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Grantor shall notify Lender at least fifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, mater almen's lien, or other lien could be asserted an account of the work, services, or materials and the cost exceeds \$10,000.00. Grantor will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

10. PROPERTY DAMAGE INSURANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property and a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall produre and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value covering all Improver ents on the Real Property in an actional sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgagee clause in favor of Lender. If the Real Property is located in an area designated by the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency as a special flood hazard area, Grantor agrees to obtain coveral Flood insurance to the extent such insurance is required and is aveilable for the term of the toan and for the full unpaid principal balance of the toan. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to center certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor shall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$10,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss in Grantor fails to do so within fifteen (15) days of the casualty. If, in Lender's judgment, the restoration or repair is economically feasible and conder's security is not lessened, insurance proceeds shall be applied to the aurins secured by this Mintgage whether or not then due, with any excess paid to Grantor. If Grantor abandons the Property, or does not answer within thirty (30) days a lotter from Lender that the Insurance particle the insurance proceeds. Lender may use the proceeds to repair or restore the Property or to pay sums secured by this Mortgage, whether or not then due.

Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall mure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provision: of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which any Existing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extant compliance with the terms of this Mortgage would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

11. EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgage, including any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or priceeding is communicid that would materially affect Lender's interests in the Property, Lander on Grantor's behalf may, upon notice to Grantor, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lender disease appropriate. Any

amount that Lender expends in so doing will bear interest at the rate charged under the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expension, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, or (b) be added to the balance of the credit tine. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights or any remedies to which Lender may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lender shall not be construed as awing the default so as to har Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

2. WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable little of record to the Property (including a leasehold interest, if any), free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except those of record, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Detense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor wairants and will tolever defend the title to the Property against the lawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and reministry of governmental authorities.

13. EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage

Existing Lien. The lien of his Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and interior to an existing lien, if there is such a lien. Grantor expressly covenant, and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

No Modification. Grantor shall not color into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, deed of trust, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which mat agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lender Grantor shall neither request nor accept any just a Advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

14. CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Morigage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the net proceeds of the award be applied to the Indebtedness known the LOANLINER® Home Equity Plan, subject to the terms of any mortgage or deep of trust with a lien which has priority over this Mortgage. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' fees necessarily paid or incurred by Grantor or Lender in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filed, Grantor shall promptly notify Lender in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to detend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Lender shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will drilliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to permit such participation.

15. IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHOFICIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, rees and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Grantor shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's herr on the Scall Property. Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or contiluuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon the type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the Indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized a required to deduct from payments on the Indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against (ne Lander or the holder of the Credit Agreement; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and in erest made by Grantor.

16. FURTHER ASSURANCES. The following provisions relating to further assurances are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. Upon request of Lender, Grantor will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Lender or to Lender's designee, and when requested by Lender, cause to be filed, recorded, refiled, or rerecorded, as the case, may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Lender may deem appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security diecis, security agreements, financing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Lender, be necessary or desirable in order to effectuate, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve. (a) the obligations of Grantor under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Documents, and. (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property. Unless prohibited by law or agreed to the confrary by Lender in writing, Grantor shall reimburse Lender for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

- 17. FLEL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the credit line account, and otherwise performs all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Crantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.
- 18. DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage. (a) Grantor commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a take statement about Grantor's income, assets, liabilities, or any other aspects of Grantor's financial condition. (b) Grantor does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Grantor's action or inaction adversely affects the collateral for the credit line account or Lender's rights in the soliateral. This can include, for example, failure to milintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Lender's permission, foreclosure by the notice of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.
- 19. GRANTOR'S RIGHT TO CURE. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default (other than fraud or material misrepresentation) and prior to exercising any of the rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or by law, Lender shall give notice as provided in the Mortgage and as required by applicable law. The notice may be combined or sent with any notice required by applicable law and shall specify: (a) the Event of Default, (b) the action required to cure the default; (c) a date not less than thirty (30) days (or any longer period as required by applicable law or elsewhere in this viorigage) from the date the notice is given to Grantor by which the default must be cured and (d) that failure to cure the default on or before the date specified in the notice may result in acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage and sale of the property. The notice shall further inform Grantor of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the high to assert in a foreclosure proceeding the nonexistence of an event of default or any other defence of Grantor to acceleration and sale. However if Lender has given Grantor a right to cure with respect to a prior Event of Default which occurred within

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three hundred sixty-five (365) days of the present event of Default, Granto, shall not be entitled to receive the right to cure described in this paragraph.

20. RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence or any Lyont of Default and at any limb thereafter, Lender, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition, or any other rights or remedies provided by law.

Accelerate Indebtedness. Londer shall have the right at its option to declare the rinker Indebtedness immediately due and payable

Mortgages in Possession. Londer shall have the right to be pluced as mortgages in possession or to have a recoiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Brints from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the Indebtedness. - 21. NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Morigage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of sale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually dilivered right in mailed, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage prepaid, directed to the ad trosses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for comenience purposes only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Grantor's Copy of Documents. Lender agrees to provide Grantor with a conformed copy of both the LOAN INCIDENT Home Equity Plan Credit Agreement and this Mortgage at the time they are executed or within a reasonable time after this Mortgage is recorded.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created birthis Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Property at any time held by or for the benefit of Lender in any capacity, without the written consent of Lender.

Severability. If a court of competent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person of circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances.
