THE COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS REFERRED TO ON PAGE 15 CTWE REVERSE SIDE OF THIS MORTGAGE):

1. Mortgagors shall (1) promptly repair, restore or rebuild any buildings or improvements now or nereafter on the premises which may become damaged or be destroyed; (2) keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from mechanic's or other liens or plainer lot lien not expressly subordinated to the lien thereof; (3) pay when due any indebtedness which may be secured by a lien or charge on the premises superior to the lien hereof, and upon request exhibit satisfactory evidence of the discharge of such prior lien to the Mortgagee; (4) complete within a reasonable time any buildings now or at any time in process of erection upon said premises; (5) comply with all requirements of law or municipal ordinances with respect to the premises and the use thereof; (6) make no material alterations in said premises except as required by law or municipal ordinance.

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- 2. - 3. - 1. Where the terms of this Rider and Mortgage conflict, the Rider shall control.
- 2. Transfer of the Property. If all or any part of the Property or any interest in it is sold or transferred without National Covenant Properties' prior written consent, National Covenant Properties may, at its option, require immediate payment in full of all sums secured by this Mortgage or Trust Deed.
