KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Harris Bank Hinsdale, National Association, formerly known as the First National Bank of Hinsdale, not personally, but as Trustee under a Deed or Deeds in "rust delivered in pursuance of a Trust Agreement dated September 6, 1984, and known as Trust Number L-900 (the "Trustee"), and Lucille E. Bekta (the "Beneficiary"), (Beneficiary and Trustee being hereinafter collectively referred to as "Assignors"), in consideration of the sum of ten and no/100 dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt and sufficiency whereof are hereby acknowledged, does hereby assign, transfer, and set over unto Harris Bank Hinsdal, e National Association (hereinafter referred to as the "Assignee"), all right, title, and interest of the Assignors or any of them, under or pursuant to any and all present or future leases or subleases, whether written or oral, or any lettings or possession of, or any agreements for the use or occupancy of, the whole or any part of the real estate and premises hereinafter described which the Assignors or any of them may have heretofore made or agreed to or may hereafter make or agree to, or which may be made or agreed to by the Assignee under the power hereinafter granted, including all amendments and supplements to and renewals thereof at any time made (collective) the "Leases"), relating to that certain real estate situated in the County of Cook, State of Illinois, described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part here(f and the improvements now or hereafter thereon (the "premises"), including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all right, title, and interest of the As phors or any of them in and to all the rents (whether fixed or contingent), earning', renewal rents, and all other sums due or which may hereafter become due under or by virtue of the Leases and all rights under or against guarantors of the obligations of the leases and obligors under the leases.

This Assignment is capte and given as collateral security for, and shall secure: (i) the payment in full of all principal of and interest on that certain promissory note of the Trustee bearing even date herewith, payable to the order of the Assignee in the face principal sum of One Million Fifty-Five Thousand and no/100 dollars (\$1,055,000.00), expressed to bear interest prior to maturity at the rate per annum of eleven and one-eighth percent (11.125%) and after maturity until paid at the rate per annum determined by adding five percent (5.0%) to the rate applicable thereto at maturity and havin, a final maturity of all principal and interest not required to be sooner paid of November 1, 1992, and any notes issued in extension or renewal thereof or in substitution therefor (the "Note"); (ii) the performance of all obligations, covenants, promises, and agreements contained herein or in that certain First Mortgage and Sevelty Agreement with Assignment of Rents bearing even date herewith from the Frustee to the Assignee (the "Mortgage"), conveying and mortgaging the premises is security for the Note and any and all other indebtedness intended to be secured thereby; (iii) the performance of all obligations, covenants, promises, and agriements of the Trustee or the Beneficiary contained in any loan or other agreements setting forth terms and conditions applicable to the loan evidenced by the Note or providing collateral security therefore; and (iv) the payment of all expenses and charges, legal or otherwise, paid or incurred by the Assignee in realizing upon or protecting the indebtedness referred to in the foregoing clauses (i), (ii), and (iii) in any security therefore, including this Assignment (the Note and other indebtediess, obligations, and liabilities referred to in clauses (i), (ii), (iii), and (iv) above being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "indebtedness hereby secured").

The Assignors do hereby irrevocably constitute and appoint the Assigner, the true and lawful attorney of the Assignors with full power of substitution for Assignors and in Assignors' name, place, and stead to ask, demand, collect, receive, receipt for, sue for, compound and give acquittance for any and all sums due or to become due under any Lease, with full power to settle, adjust, or compromise any claim thereunder as fully as the Assignors could do, and to endorse the name of the Assignors or any of them on all commercial paper given in payment or in part payment thereof, and in the Assignee's discretion to file any claim or take any other action or proceeding, either in the Assignee's name or in the name of the Assignors or any of them or otherwise, which the Assignee may deem necessary or appropriate to protect and preserve the right, title, and interest of the Assignee in and to such sums and the security intended to be afforded hereby.

to make this Assignment and that the Assignors have not heretofore alienated, assigned, pledged, or otherwise disposed of any of the rights, rents, and other sums due or which may hereafter become due and which are intended to be assigned hereunder.

This Assignment includes and establishes a present, absolute, and primary transfer and assignment of all rents, carnings, income, issues and profits of the premises, but so long as no event of default shall exist under the Note or the Mortgage and no event shall exist which by lapse of time or service of notice, or both, has or would become an event of default thereunder, the Assignors shall have the right and license to collect, use, and enjoy all rents and other sums due or to become due under and by virtue of any Lease as they respectively become due, but not more than 30 days in advance.

The Assignors hereby irrevocably consent to and authorize and direct that the tenant or other obligor under any Lease upon demand and notice from the Assignee of the Assignee's right to receive rents and other sums hereunder, shall pay such rents and other sums to the Assignee without any obligation on the part of such tenant or other obligor to determine the actual existence of any default or event claimed by the Assignee as the basis for the Assignee's right to receive such rents or other sums, notwithstanding any notice from or claim of the Assignors or any of them to the contrary. The Assignors hereby waive any right or claim against any tenant or other obligor for any such rents and other sums paid by tenant or other obligor to the Assignee.

Without limiting any legal rights of the Assignee as the absolute assignee of the rents, issues, and profits of the premises and in furtherance thereof, Assignors agree that in the event of cofault under said Mortgage, whether before or after the Note is declared due in accordance with its terms or under the terms of said Mortgage and whether before or efter satisfaction of any requirement of the lapse of time or the giving of notice or both on which acceleration after default may be conditioned, the Assignee may, we its option, (i) take actual possession of the premises hereinabove described, or pay part thereof, personally or by agent or attorney, as for condition broken, and with or without force and with or without process of law, enter upon, take and main an possession of all or any part of said premises, together with all documents, books, records, papers, and accounts relating thereto, and exclude the Assignors, their agents or servants, therefrom and hold, operate, manage, and control the premises, and at the expense of the premises, from time to time, cause to be made all necessary or proper repairs, renewals, replacements, useful alteration, additions, betterments, and improvements to the premises as may seem judicious, and pay taxes, assessments and prior or proper charges on the premises, or any part thereof, and insure and reinsure the same, and lease the premises in such parcels and for such times and on such terms as Assignce may deem lit, including leases for terms expiring beyond the maturity of the indebtedness secured by said Mortgage, and cancel an Vease or sublease for any cause or on any ground which would entitle the Assignors of any of them to cancel the same and in every such case have the right to manage and operate the said premises and to carry on the business thereof as the Assignee shall deem proper; or (ii) with or without taking possession of the premises. - (c) to the cost of completing any improvements being constructed on or about the premises; and
- (d) to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured, whether or not the same may then be due or be otherwise adequately secured.

The manner of application of such sums and the items which shall be credited or paid out of same shall be within the sole discretion of Assignee, and nothing herein contained shall obligate Assignee to use any such sums for a purpose other than reducing the indebtedness hereby secured unless it shall elect to do so. Assignee shall be subrogated to any lien discharged out of the rents, income, and profits of premises.

Assignce shall have no liability to Assignors or anyone for any action taken or omitted to be taken by it hereunder, except for its willful misconduct. Should the Assignee incur any liability, loss, or damage under or by reason of this Assignment or for any action taken by the Assignee hereunder, or in defense against any claim or demand whatsoever which may be asserted against the Assignce arising out of any Lease, the amount thereof, including costs, expenses, and reasonable attorneys' fees, together with interest thereon at the rate applicable to the Note at the time of incurrence (or if the Note has been paid in full at the time of incurrence, then at the rate applicable to the Note at the time of such payment in full), shall be secured by this Assignment and by the Mortgage; and the Assignors shall reimburse the Assignce therefor immediately upon demand, Assignors' obligations so to pay to survive payment of the indebtedness hereby secured and the release of this agreement.

The rights and remedies of the Assignce hereunder are cumulative and are not

secondary to or in lieu of, but are in addition to any rights or remedies which the Assignee shall have under the said Note, Mortgage, or any other instrument or document or under applicable law and the exercise by Assignee of any rights and remedies herein contained shall not be deemed a waiver of any other rights or remedies of Assignee, whether arising under the Mortgage or otherwise, each and all of which may be exercised whenever Assignee deems it in its interest to do so. The rights and remedies of the Assignee may be exercised from time to time and as often as such exercise is deemed expedient and the failure of the Assignee to enforce any of the terms, provisions, and conditions of this Assignment for any period of time, at any time or times, shall not be construed or deemed to be a waiver of any rights under the terms hereof.

The right of the Assignee to collect and receive the rents assigned hereunder or to exercise any of the rights or powers herein granted to the Assignee shall, to the extent not prohibited by law, extend also to the period from and after the filing of any suit to foreclose the lien of the Mortgage, including any period allowed by law for the redemption of the premises after any foreclosure sale.

This Assignment shall be assignable by the Assignee; and all of the terms and provisions hereof shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the respective executors, admiristrators, legal representatives, successors, and assigns of each of the parties hereo. All provisions hereof are severable and if any provisions hereof shall be in alid or unenforceable, the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions bereof shall in no way be affected thereby.
