

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a tien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether raid or personal, halonging to such person.

## Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer ansing out of such Rability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors .- The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment-liembreditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

#### n Place For Filing Notice; Form.—

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed .

(A) Under State Laws

(I) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one \* office within the State (or the county, or other governmental aubdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to this lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - in the case of personal prop erty, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds CI The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated -(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location, or

(B) Personal Property - In the case of personal property where it tangible or intangible, at the resitance of the taxlayer at the time the notice of lien is fied.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partner thin shall be deemed to be the place at which the princlosel executivy off the of the business is located, and the repldence of a tampar in whose residence is without the United States shall be dueyled to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and lontent of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. But hindline shall be valid not with structing any other provision of aw regarding the form or content of this ice of lien.

Note: See section 6323(5) for protection for certain interests even though notice of lien imposed by section 6321 is filed with respect to:

- 1. Securities
- Motor vehicles
- Personal property purchased at retail
- Personal property purchased in casual sale

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule, -- Unless notice of en is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required retiling period, such notice of tien shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection if)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (b) Place For Filling. A notice of tien refiled during the required refling period shall be effective only. (A) if:

  - et such notice at ken is cetted in the other in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
  - (a) in the case of real property, the fact of religing is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
  - (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date. S of a refiling of notice of lien under subparegraph (A), the

Secretary received written information (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary concerning a change in the texpayer's residence. If a notice of each lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 8 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the placeding required refiling period for such natice of Len

# Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any fien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary linds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable, or
- (2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and acciping by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, y thin the time prescribed by law (including any extenaion of slich tiriet, and that is in accordance with such requirements religing to imag, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as hay be specified by such regulations.

## Sec. 5103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

#### 4. Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -
