

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may appropriate additional material shall be a len in layor of the Diffield States upon the property and rights to property, whethat the brights and belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322 Period Of Lien.

Unless another date to grandfally fixed by law, the lief line posed by section 6321 shall sale at the time the assessment he made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Sacurity In-turests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The Jen Impleed by section 521 shall not be reall as easiers any purchases, holder of a security interest, mechanic's ferror, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(3) Form - The long and content of the notice referred to the subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary. Such notice shall be valid notware anding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (1) General Rule: Unless notice of lian is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reflling period, such notice of tien small be troated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(a) Release Of Lien. - "Subject to such regular tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all in-terest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accipled by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, logather with all interest in respect thereof, much the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such I me), and that is in accordance with such requiremants relating to forme, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties theteon, as may be specified by such regulations.

(A) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.~

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.-If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be declared to any person who lumishes satisfactory written exidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
