

# Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

## Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition is tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accept in addition thereto) shall be a len in favor of the United States upon at property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

# Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

## c. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors.—The fien imposed by section 8321 shall not be valid assignant, any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lenor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be illed -

(i) Real Property in the case of real property, in one in office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivisk in as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the len is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property: In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State; in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Ct District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the properly subject to lien its situated, Whenever the State has not by is w designated one office which meets the requirements

of subparagraph (A), or

(C): With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbiain the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of Columbia.

payer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refilling Of Notice. For purposes of this
- (1) General Rule.—Unless notice of lien is railled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliting period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refitting period.
- (2) Place For Filling.—A notice of tien refiled during the required refiting period shall be effective only

- (i) such notice of Iten is refiled in the office in which the prior notice of Iten was filed, and
- (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
- (B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a retiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

# Sec. 6325. Release Of Lian Or Discharge Of Property

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may proscribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unenforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of he amount assessed, together with all interest in respectively. The time prescribed by the (including any externation of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements returned to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations.

# Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding fient. If a notice of lian has been filed pursuant to section 6323(!), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such fien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
