

## Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon ell property and nights to property, whether test or persons, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the light imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall confinder until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such liability is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse of time.

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors,—The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

Place For Filing - The notice reterred to in subsection
 (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(t) Rest Property - In the case of rest property, in one

\* § office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated, and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tarigible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-in the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to flen is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements.

(g) Refiling Of Notice. — For purposes of this section -

(1) **General Rule**, —Unless notice of tien is refued in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling period such notice of tion shall be treated as filed on the date on which it is filed in andorgance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refilling period.

(2) Place For Filling. —A notice of ten refited during the required refiling period shall be effective only.

(A) A

(i) such notice of lien is refuled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refilling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of ilen under subparagraph (A), the

Secretary received written enformation (in the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lien is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such readence is located.

(a) Required Refilling Period.—in the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refilling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required refilling period for such notice of lien.

Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 done after the day on which.

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable. The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become.

legally unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of he amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such time), and that is in accordance with such requirements in the bond and surelies the sor, as may be specified by such regulations.

Sec. \$103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

A: Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes.—
