

# Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

#### Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether read or personal, belonging to such person

### Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date in appathcally fixed by law, the ken imposed by section 8321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until "he liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against tim axpayer arising out of such Sability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The ten imposed by section 8021 shall not be vaild as against any purchaser, holder o a populty interest, mechanic's liency or plagment lien creditor until ace thereof which meets the recurrensiate of authoritor of has been filed by the Secretary

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of agraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its infrysical location, or

(B) Personal Property - in the case of personal property Pretict tangible or intangible, at the residence of the laxpayer at the time the notice of lien is fied.

For purpose of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation. or partne, while shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive off be of the business is located, and the residence of a facust of whose residence is without the United States shall be due ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The form and content of the nutice referred to in authorition (a) shall is prescribed by the Secretary Suith notice shall be valid notwinistrately any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of lien.

(2) Place For Filing. - A notice of tien refiled during the required refining period shall be effective only -

(B) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the

(i) Required Refiling Period.—In the case of any notice of tien, the term "required refiling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required retiling period for such pouce of ken.

## Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to nuch regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolease of any hen imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liebility Satisfied or Unenterpeable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, icgether with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unemforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount sassessed, toomher with all interest in respect thereof, within the time prescribed by law (including any extension of Just tries and that is in accordance with such requirements relaying to froms, conditions, and form of the bond and suration thereon as may be specified by such regulations.
