

Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, additional amount, addition to lax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a fen in layor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person, (2) 1211

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 5321, shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall consinue end the lability for the amount so Messed (or a Judgment against the taxpeyer arising out of such mb@h) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

\$6c. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The Ben imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (fr tes been flied by the Secretary.

n Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (e) shall be flied -

(A) Under State Laws

· (i)·-Real Property · In the case of real property. In one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property in the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the taws of such State, in which the property subject to the ken is situated; or

(B) With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to item is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

(2) Silus Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical location; or .

Personal Property - in the case of personal property, other tangible or intangible, at the residence of the tax-

payer at the time the notice of tien is filed.

Fo. ourpower of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partnership shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal execut a citice of the business is located; and the residence of a targer at whose residence is without the United States shall be use med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and conjunt of the notice referred to in extraction (a) shall be preparated by the Secretary. Such notice that be valid notice of any other provision of law regarding the form of content of a notice of lien.

- (g) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section .
- (1) General Rule. Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refilling pariod, such notice of fien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing: A notice of lien refiled during the required reliling period shall be effective only -
 - (A) il-
 - (i) such notice of tien is reflied in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and
 - (ii) in the case of real property, the fact of refiling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and
 - (B) In any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date () of a retiling of notice of tien under subparagraph (A), the

for such notice of lien. Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

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- (a) Release Of Lien. Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -
- (1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable The Secretary finds that the flability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable; or
- (2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment c to a amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, y ann the time prescribed by law (including any extension of a uch time), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating in terms, conditions, and form of the bond and surelles thereon, as may be specified by such regulations.

- (2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.-If a notice of lien has been filled pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes salisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such flen or intends to obtain a right in such property.

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
