MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE 'S DATED DECEMBER 18, 1989, between Clifford F. Compton and Denice C. Compton, his wife, in joint tenancy, whose address is 1203 Alexander, Streamwood, IL 60103 (referred to below as "Grantor"); and First American Bank of Kane County, whose address is 218 West Main Street, West Dundee, IL 60118 (referred to below as "Lender").

GRANT OF MORTGAGE. For valuable consideration, Grantor mortgages, warrants, and conveys to Lender all of Grantor's right, life, and interest in and to the following described real property together with all existing or subsequently elected or altixed buildings, improvements and fixtures; all easements, rights of way, and appurtenances, it water, water rights, watercourses and disch rights (including stock in utilities with disch or impalien rights); and all other rights, royalties, and profits retained to the real property, including without limitation all minerals, oil, gas, geothermal and similar matters, located in Cook County, State of Illinois (the "Real Property"):

Lot 4208 in Woodland Heights Unit 11, being a Subdivision in Section 26, Township 41 North, Range 9, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in temover Township, according to the Plat thereof Recorded in the Recorder's Office June 24, 1969 as Document No. 20880926, in Cook County, Illinois.

The Real Property or Its address is commonly known as 1203 Alexander, Streamwood, IL 60103. The Real Property tax identification number is 06-26-412-010.

Grantor presently assigns to Londor all of Grantor's right, title, and interest in and to all leases of the Property and all Rents from the Property. In addition, Grantor grants to Londor a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in the Personal Property and Rents.

DEFINITIONS. The following words shall have the following meanings when used in this Mortgage. Terms not otherwise defined in this Mortgage shall have the meanings attributed to such terms in the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Credit Agreement. The words "Credit Agreement" mean the revolving line of credit agreement dated December 18, 1989, between Londer and Granter with a credit limit of \$29,000.00, together with all renewals of, extensions of modifications of, relinancings of, consolidations of, and substitutions for the Credit Agreement. The maturity date of this Mortgage is December 18, 1994. The interest rate under the revolving line of credit is a variable interest rate based upon an index. The index currently is 10.500% for annum. The interest rate to be applied to the outstanding account balance shall be at a rate 2,000 percentage points above the index for planted of \$24,999.99 and under, at a rate 1,000 percentage points above the index for balances of \$25,000.00 to \$49,999.99, and at a rate equal to the index for balances of \$50,000.00 and above, subject however to the following maximum rate. Under no circumstances shall the interest rate be more than the lesser of 18,000% per annum or the maximum rate allowed by applicable law. The maturity date of this Mortgage is December 18, 1194.

Existing Indebtedness. The words "Existing Indebtedness" mean the Indebtedness described below in the Existing Indebtedness section of this Mortgage.

Grantor. The word "Grantor" means Chillord F. Compton and Dunico C. Compton. The Grantor is the mortgagor und a this Mortgago.

Quarantor. The word "Guarantor" means and includes without limitation each and all of the guarantors, sureties, and accommodation parties in connection with the Indebtodness.

improvements. The word "improvements" means and includes without limitation all existing and luture improvements, fixtures, buildings, structures, mobile homes affixed on the Real Property, facilities, additions and other construction on the Real Property.

Indebtedness. The word "indebtedness" means all principal and interest payable under the Credit Agreement and any amounts expended or advanced by Lender to discharge obligations of Granter or expenses incurred by Lender to enforce obligations of Granter under this Mortgage, together with interest on such amounts as provided in this Mortgage. Specifically, without limitation, this Mortgage secures a revolving line of credit, which obligates Lender to make advances to Granter so long as Granter compiles with all the terms of the Credit Agreement. Such advances may be made, repaid, and remade from time to time, subject to the limitation that the total outstanding balance owing at any one time, not including finance charges on such balance at a fixed or variable rate or sum as provided in the Credit Agreement, any temporary overages, other charges, and any amounts expended or advanced as provided in this paragraph, shall not exceed the Credit Limit as provided in the Credit Agreement. It is the intention of Granter and Lender that this Mortgage secures the balance outstanding under the Credit Agreement from time to time from zero up to the Credit Limit as provided above and any intermediate balance.

Lender. The word "Lender" means First American Bank of Kane County, its successors and assigns. The Lender is the mortgage under this Mortgage.

Mortgage. The word "Mortgage" means this Mortgage between Grantor and Lender, and Includes without limitation all assignments and security interest provisions relating to the Personal Property and Rents.

Personal Property. The words "Personal Property" mean all equipment, fixtures, and other articles of personal property new or hereafter owned by Granter, and new or hereafter attached or affixed to the Real Property; together with all accessions, parts, and additions to, all replacements of, and all substitutions for, any of such property; and together with all proceeds (including without limitation all insurance proceeds and refunds of

premiums) from any sale or other disposition of the Property.

Property. The word "Property" means collectively the Real Property and the Personal Property.

Real Property. The words "Real Property" mean the property, interests and rights described above in the "Grant of Mortgage" section.

Related Documents. The words "Related Documents" mean and include without limitation all promissory notes, cridit agreements, loan agreements, guaranties, security agreements, mortgages, deeds of trust, and all other instruments and documents, whether now or herealter existing, executed in connection with Grantor's Indebtedness to Lender.

Rents. The word "Rents" means all present and future rents, revenues, income, lesues, reyalties, profits, and other benefits derived from the Property.

THIS MORTGAGE, INCLUDING THE ASSIGNMENT OF RENTS AND THE SECURITY INTEREST IN THE RENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY, IS GIVEN TO SECURE (1) PAYMENT OF THE INDEBTEDNESS AND (2) PERFORMANCE OF ALL OBLIGATIONS OF GRANTOR UNDER THIS MORTGAGE AND THE RELATED DOCUMENTS. THIS MORTGAGE IS GIVEN AND ACCEPTED ON THE FOLLOWING TERMS:

PAYMENT AND PERFORMANCE. Except as otherwise provided in this Mortgage, Grantor shall pay to Lander all amounts secured by this Mortgage as they become due, and shall strictly perform all of Grantor's obligations under this Mortgage.

POSSESSION AND AND TENANCE OF THE PROPERTY. Grantor agrees that Grantor's possession and use of the Property shall be governed by the following provisions:

Possession and Usc. Until in default, Grantor may remain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Rents from the Property.

Duty to Maintain. Granter she I maintain the Property in tenantable condition and promptly perform all repairs, replacements, and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.

Hazardous Substances. The terms "hazardous waste," "hazardous substance," "disposal," "release," and "threatened release," as used in this Mortgage, shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Comprehensive Environmental Response. Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, as amended, 42 U.S.C. Section 9601, et sort. ("CERCLA"), the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, Pub. L. No. 99-499 ("SARA"), the Hazardous Materials Transportation Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 1801, et soq., the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, 49 U.S.C. Section 6901, at seq., or other applicable state of Foderal laws, rules, or regulations adopted pursuant to any of the foregoing. Granter impresents and warrants to Lender that: (a) During the veried of Granter's ownership of the Property, there has been no use, generation, manufacture, storage, treatment, disposal, release or threatened elease of any hazardous waste or substance by any person on, under, or about the Property. (b) Grantor has no knowledge of, or reason to believe in at there has been, except as previously disclosed to and acknowledged by Lender in writing, (I) any use, generation, manufacture, storage, tentrient, disposal, release, or threatened release of any hazardous waste or substance by any prior owners or occupants of the Property or (ii) any actual or threatened litigation or claims of any kind by any person relating to such matters. (c) Except as previously disclosed to and acknowled and by Lender in writing, (i) neither Granter nor any tenant, contractor, agent or other authorized user of the Property shall use, generate, manufacture, store, treat, dispose of, or release any hazardous waste or substance on, under, or about the Property and (ii) any such activity shall be conducted in compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including without limitation those laws, regulations, and ordinances described above. Granter authorizes Londer and its agents to enter upon the Property to make such inspections and Lary as Lunder may deem appropriate to determine compliance of the Property with this section of the Mortgage. Any inspections or tests made by Lunder shall be for Lender's purposes only and shall not be construed to create any responsibility or liability on the part of Londor to Granfor or to any other person. The representations and warranties contained herein are based on Grantor's due diligence in investigating the Property for hazardous waiste. Grantor hereby (a) releases and waives any future claims against Lender for indomnity or contribution in the event Grantor brooms liable for cleanup or other costs under any such laws, and (b) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Londer against any and all claims, losses, liabilities, damages, penalties, and expenses which Lender may directly or indirectly sustain or suffer resulting from a breach of this section of the Mortgage or as a consequence of any use, generation, manufacture, storage, disposal, release or threatened release occurring provide Crantor's ownership or interest in the Property, whother or not the same was or should have been known to Grantor. The provisions of this section of the Mortgage, including the obligation to indomnity, shall survive the payment of the Indebtedness and the satisfaction and reconveyance of the lion of this Mortgage and shall not be affected by Lendor's acquisition of any interest in the Property, whether by foreclosure or otherwise.

Nulsance, Wasts. Grantor shall not cause, conduct or permit any nulsance nor commit, permit, or sulfur any stripping of or waste on or to the Property. Specifically without limitation, Grantor will not remove, or grant to any other party the right to remove, any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), soil, gravel or rock products without the prior written consent of Lender.

Removal of Improvements. Grantor shall not domolish or remove any Improvements from the Real Property walkest the prior written consent of Lender. As a condition to the removal of any Improvements, Lender may require Grantor to make arrangements shift-tectory to Lender to replace such Improvements with Improvements of at least equal value.

Lender's Right to Enter. Lender and its agents and representatives may enter upon the Real Property at all reasonable tinus to attend to Lender's interests and to inspect the Property for purposes of Grantor's compliance with the terms and conditions of this Mortgage.

Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations, now or hereafter in effect, of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property. Grantor may contest in good latth any such law, ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during any proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Lendor in writing prior to doing so and so long as Lender's interests in the Property are not joopardized. Lender may require Grantor to post adequate security or a surely bond, reasonably satisfactory to Lender, to protect Lender's interest.

Duty to Protect. Grantor agrees neither to abandon nor leave unattended the Property. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those acts set forth above in this section, which from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the Property.

DUE ON SALE - CONSENT BY LENDER. Lender may, at its option, declare immediately due and payable all sums secured by this Mortgage upon the sale or transfer, without the Lender's prior written consent, of all or any part of the Real Property, or any interest in the Real Property. A "sale or transfer" means the conveyance of real property or any right, title or interest therein; whether legal or equitable; whether voluntary or involuntary; whether by outright sale, doed, installment sale contract, contract for doed, leasehold interest with a form greater than three (3) years, lease-option contract, or by sale, assignment, or transfer of any beneficial interest in or to any land trust holding title to the Real Property, or by any other method of conveyance of real property interest. If any Granter is a corporation or partnership, transfer also includes any change in ownership of more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the voting stock or partnership interests, as the case may be, of Granter. However, this option shall not be exercised by Lender if such exercise is prohibited by federal law or by Illinois law.

TAXES AND LIENS. The following provisions relating to the taxes and tiens on the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Payment. Grantor shall pay when due (and in all events prior to delinquency) all taxes, payroll taxes, apsessments, water charges

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and sower service charges levied against or on account of the Property, and shall pay when due all claims for work done on or for services rendered or material furnished to the Property. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of all liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Lender under this Mortgage, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the Existing Indebtedness referred to below, and except as otherwise provided in the following paragraph.

Right To Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Lender's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within fifteen (15) days after the lien arises or, if a lien is filed, within fifteen (15) days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the filen, or if requested by Lender, deposit with Lender cash or a sufficient corporate surety bond or other security satisfactory to Lender in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs and attorneys' fees or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien. In any contest, Grantor shall defend itself and Lender and shall satisfy any adverse judgment before enforcement against the Property. Grantor shall name Lender as an additional obligee under any surety bond furnished in the contest proceedings.

Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnish to Londor satisfactory evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate governmental official to deliver to Londor at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.

Notice of Construction. Granter shall notify Lender at least lifteen (15) days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property, if any mechanic's lien, materialmen's lien, or other lien could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials any the cost exceeds \$10,000.00. Granter will upon request of Lender furnish to Lender advance assurances satisfactory to Lender that Granter can and will pay the cost of such improvements.

PROPERTY DAMAGE IN SUF ANCE. The following provisions relating to insuring the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of lire insurance with standard extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full visurable value covering all improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause, and with a standard mortgaged clause in layor of Lender. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acrepiable to Lender. Grantor shall deliver to Lender certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of ten (10) days' prior written notice to Lender.

Application of Proceeds. Grantor stall promptly notify Lender of any loss or damage to the Property if the estimated cost of repair or replacement exceeds \$10,000.00. Lender may make proof of loss if Grantor fails to do so within lifteen (15) days of the casualty. Whether or not Lender's security is impaired, Lender may, at it's election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the indubtedness, payment of any lien affecting the Property, or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Lender elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Grantor shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Improvements in a manner satisfactory to Lender. Lender shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Grantor from the proceeds for the mass nable cost of repair or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been disbursed within 180 days after the local transparent or restoration if Grantor is not in default hereunder. Unexpired insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inute to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered by this Mortgage at any trustee's sale or other sale held under the provisions of this Mortgage, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.

Compliance with Existing Indebtedness. During the period in which any Ensing Indebtedness described below is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions contained in the instrument evidencing such Existing Inner advances shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Mortgage, to the extent compliance with the terms of this Mortgage, would constitute a duplication of insurance requirement. If any proceeds from the insurance become payable on loss, the provisions in this Mortgage for division of proceeds shall apply only to that portion of the proceeds not payable to the holder of the Existing Indebtedness.

EXPENDITURES BY LENDER. If Grantor fails to comply with any provision of this Mortgago, in cityling any obligation to maintain Existing Indebtedness in good standing as required below, or if any action or proceeding is commenced that would materially affect Londor's interests in the Property, Lender on Grantor's behalf may, but shall not be required to, take any action that Lendor dooms appropriate. Any amount that Lender expends in so doing will be partially at the rate charged under the Credit Agreement from the date incurred or paid by Lender to the date of repayment by Grantor. All such expenses, at Lender's option, will (a) be payable on demand, (b) be added to the balance of the Credit line and be apportioned among and be payable with any installment payments to become due during either (i) the term of any applicable insurance, policy or (ii) the remaining term of the Credit Agreement, or (c) be treated as a balloon payment which will be due and payable at the Credit Agreement, the maturity. This Mortgage also will secure payment of these amounts. The rights provided for in this paragraph shall be in addition to any other rights any remedies to which Londer may be entitled on account of the default. Any such action by Lendor shall not be construed as curing the default so to but Lender from any remedy that it otherwise would have had.

WARRANTY; DEFENSE OF TITLE. The following provisions relating to ownership of the Property are a part of this Mortging.

Title. Grantor warrants that: (a) Grantor holds good and marketable title of record to the Property in fee ample, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances other than those set forth in the Real Property description or in the Existing Indebtedness section below or in any title insurance policy, title report, or final title opinion issued in favor of, and accepted by, Londer in connection with this Mortgage, and (b) Grantor has the full right, power, and authority to execute and deliver this Mortgage to Lender.

Defense of Title. Subject to the exception in the paragraph above, Grantor warrants and will forever defend the title to the Property against the tawful claims of all persons. In the event any action or proceeding is commenced that questions Grantor's title or the interest of Londer under this Mortgage, Grantor shall defend the action at Grantor's expense. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Londer shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver, or cause to be delivered, to Londer such instruments as Londer may request from time to time to permit such participation.

Compliance With Laws. Grantor warrants that the Property and Grantor's use of the Property complies with all existing applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of governmental authorities.

EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS. The following provisions concerning existing indebtedness (the "Existing Indebtedness") are a part of this Mortgage.

Existing Lien. The lien of this Mortgage securing the Indebtedness may be secondary and Inferior to the lien securing payment of an existing obligation to Advance Mortgage Corporation. The existing obligation has a current principal balance of approximately \$39,500.00 and is in the original principal amount of \$45,900.00. Granter expressly covenants and agrees to pay, or see to the payment of, the Existing Indebtedness and to prevent any default on such indebtedness, any default under the instruments evidencing such indebtedness, or any default under any security documents for such indebtedness.

No Modification. Granter shall not enter into any agreement with the holder of any mortgage, dood of first, or other security agreement which has priority over this Mortgage by which that agreement is modified, amended, extended, or renewed without the prior written consent of Lender.

Grantor shall neither request nor accept any future advances under any such security agreement without the prior written consent of Lender.

CONDEMNATION. The following provisions relating to condemnation of the Property are a part of this Mortgage.

Application of Net Proceeds. If all or any part of the Property is condemned by ominion domain proceedings or by any proceeding or purchase in lieu of condemnation, Lender may at its election require that all or any portion of the proceeds of the award of the award of the award of the property. The net proceeds of the award shall mean the award after payment of all reasonable costs, expenses, and attorneys' less necessarily paid or incurred by Granter or Londer in connection with the condemnation.

Proceedings. If any proceeding in condemnation is filled, Grantor shall promptly notify Londor in writing, and Grantor shall promptly take such steps as may be necessary to defend the action and obtain the award. Grantor may be the nominal party in such proceeding, but Londor shall be entitled to participate in the proceeding and to be represented in the proceeding by counsel of its own choice, and Grantor will deliver or cause to be delivered to Lender such instruments as may be requested by it from time to time to permit such participation.

IMPOSITION OF TAXES, FEES AND CHARGES BY GOVERNMENTAL AUTHORITIES. The following provisions relating to governmental taxes, fines and charges are a part of this Mortgage:

Current Taxes, Fees and Charges. Upon request by Lender, Granter shall execute such documents in addition to this Mortgage and take whatever other action is requested by Lender to perfect and continue Lender's lien on the Real Property. Granter shall reimburie Lender for all taxes, as described below, together with all expenses incurred in recording, perfecting or continuing this Mortgage, including without limitation all taxes, fees, documentary stamps, and other charges for recording or registering this Mortgage.

Taxes. The following shall constitute taxes to which this section applies: (a) a specific tax upon this type of Mortgage or upon all or any part of the indebtedness secured by this Mortgage; (b) a specific tax on Grantor which Grantor is authorized or required to deduct from payments on the indebtedness secured by this type of Mortgage; (c) a tax on this type of Mortgage chargeable against the Londer or the holder of the Credit Agreement; and (d) a specific tax on all or any portion of the Indebtedness or on payments of principal and interest made by Grantor.

Subsequent Taxes. If any tax to which this section applies is enacted subsequent to the date of this Mortgage, this event shall have the same effect as an Event of Default (as defined below), and Lender may exercise any or all of its available remedies for an Event of Default as provided below unless Granter either. (a) pays the tax before it becomes delinquent, or (b) contests the tax as provided above in the Taxes and Liens section and deposits with Lender cash in a sufficient corporate surely bond or other security substactory to Lender.

SECURITY AGREEMENT; FINANCING STATEMENTS. The following provisions relating to this Mortgage as a security agreement are a part of this Mortgage.

Security Agreement. Addresses. The mailing addresses of Granter (debter) and Lender (secting) party), from which information concerning the security interest granted by this Mortgage may be obtained (each as required by the Illinoir Uniform Commercial Code), are as stated on the tirst page of this Mortgage.

FURTHER ASSURANCES; ATTORNEY-IN-FACT. The following provisions relating to further assurances and attorney-in-fact are a part of this Mortgage.

Further Assurances. At any time, and from time to time, upon request of Londer, Granter will make, execute and deliver, or will cause to be made, executed or delivered, to Londer or to Londer's designee, and when requested by Londer, cause to be filed, recorded, refiled, or refeccided, as the case may be, at such times and in such offices and places as Londer may down appropriate, any and all such mortgages, deeds of trust, security deeds, security agreements, linancing statements, continuation statements, instruments of further assurance, certificates, and other documents as may, in the sole opinion of Londer, be necessary or destrable in order to effect on organic, complete, perfect, continue, or preserve (a) the obligations of Granter under the Credit Agreement, this Mortgage, and the Related Discurrents, and (b) the liens and security interests created by this Mortgage on the Property, whether now owned or hereafter acquired by Granter. Jr. See prohibited by law or agreed to the contrary by Londer in writing, Granter shall reimburse Londer for all costs and expenses incurred in connection with the matters referred to in this paragraph.

Attorney-in-Fact. If Grantor tails to do any of the things referred to in the preceding paragraph, Lender may do so for and in the name of Grantor and at Grantor's expense. For such purposes, Grantor hereby irrevocably appoints Lender as Grantor's attorney-in-fact for the purpose of making, executing, delivering, filling, recording, and doing all other things as may be necessary or desirable, in Lender's sole opinion, to accomplish the matters referred to in the preceding paragraph.

FULL PERFORMANCE. If Grantor pays all the Indebtedness when due, terminates the credit line account, and otherwise portorms all the obligations imposed upon Grantor under this Mortgage, Lender shall execute and deliver to Grantor a suitable satisfaction of this Mortgage and suitable statements of termination of any financing statement on file evidencing Lender's security interest in the Rents and the Personal Property. Grantor will pay, if permitted by applicable law, any reasonable termination fee as determined by Lender from time to time.

DEFAULT. Each of the following, at the option of Lender, shall constitute an event of default ("Event of Default") under this Mortgage: (a) Granter commits fraud or makes a material misrepresentation at any time in connection with the credit line account. This can include, for example, a later statement about Granter's income, assets, fiabilities, or any other aspects of Granter's financial condition. (b) Granter does not meet the repayment terms of the credit line account. (c) Granter's action or inaction adversely affects the collectual for the credit line account or Londer's rights in the collateral. This can include, for example, failure to maintain required insurance, waste or destructive use of the dwelling, failure to pay taxes, death of all persons liable on the account, transfer of title or sale of the dwelling, creation of a lien on the dwelling without Londer's permission, fereclosure by the holder of another lien, or the use of funds or the dwelling for prohibited purposes.

RIGHTS AND REMEDIES ON DEFAULT. Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default and at any time thereafter, Londer, at its option, may exercise any one or more of the following rights and remedies, in addition to any other rights or remedies provided by law:

Accelerate Indebtedness. Lender shall have the right at its option without notice to Grantor to doctare the entire Indebtedness immediately due and payable, including any prepayment penalty which Grantor would be required to pay.

UCC Remedies. With respect to all or any part of the Personal Property, Lander shall have all the rights and remedies of a secured party under the Illinois Uniform Commercial Code.

Collect Rents. Lender shall have the right, without notice to Granter, to take possession of the Property and collect the Rents, including amounts past due and unpaid, and apply the net proceeds, over and above Lender's costs, against the indebtedness. In furtherance of this right, Lender may require any tenant or other user of the Property to make payments of rent or use toos directly to Lender. If the Rents are collected by Lender, then Granter irrevocably designates Lender as Granter's atterney-in-fact to enderse instruments received in payment thereof in the name of Granter and to negotiate the same and collect the proceeds. Payments by tenants or other users to Lender in response to Lender may exercise its rights under this subparagraph either in person, by agent, or through a receiver.

Mortgages in Possession. Londor shall have the right to be placed as mortgages in possession or to have a receiver appointed to take possession of all or any part of the Property, with the power to protect and preserve the Property, to operate the Property preceding foreclosure or sale, and to collect the Rents from the Property and apply the proceeds, over and above the cost of the receivership, against the indebtodness. The mortgages in possession or receiver may serve without bond if permitted by law. London's right to the appointment of a receiver shall exist whether or not the apparent vake of the Property exceeds the Indebtodness by a substantial amount. Employment by London shall not disquality a person from serving as a receiver.

Judicial Foreclosure. Lender may obtain a judicial decree foreclosing Grantor's interest in all or any part of the Property

Deficiency Judgment. If permitted by applicable law, Londor may obtain a judgment for any deficiency remaining in the Indebtedness due to Lender after application of all amounts received from the exercise of the rights provided in this section.

Other Remedies. Lender shall have all other rights and remedies provided in this Mortgage or the Credit Agreement or available at law or in equity.

Sale of the Property. To no extent permitted by applicable law, Grantor hereby waives any and all right to have the property marshalled. In exercising its rights and removing, Londor shall be free to sell all or any part of the Property together or separately, in one sale or by separate sales. Lendor shall be entitled to bid at any public sale on all or any portion of the Property.

Notice of Sale. Lander shall give stantor reasonable notice of the time and place of any public sale of the Personal Property or of the time after which any private sale or other interded disposition of the Personal Property is to be made. Reasonable notice shall mean notice given at least ten (10) days before the time of the sale or disposition.

Waiver; Election of Remedies. A waiver of any party of a breach of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a waiver of or prejudice the party's rights otherwise to demand strict complie an with that provision or any other provision. Election by Lender to pursue any remedy shall not exclude pursuit of any other remody, and an election to make expenditures or take action to perform an obligation of Grantor under this Mortgage after failure of Grantor to perform shall not affect Lender's right to declare a default and exercise its remedies under this Mortgage.

Attorneys' Fees; Expenses. If Lender institutes any station action to enforce any of the terms of this Mortgage, Lender shall be entitled to recover such sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attempted foos at that and on any appeal. Whether or not any court action is involved, all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender that in Lender's epinion are necessary at any time for the protection of its interest or the enforcement of its rights shall become a part of the indebtedness payable on demand and shall bear interest from the date of expenditure until repaid at the Credit Agreement rate. Expenses govered by this paragraph include, without limitation, however subject to any limits under applicable law. Lender's attorneys' fors and legal expenses whether or not there is a lawsuit, including attorneys' tous for bankruptcy proceedings (including efforts to modify or vacate any automatic stay or injunction), appeals and any anticipated post-judgment collection survices, the cost of searching records, obtaining title reports (including foreclosure reports), surveyors and special fees, and title insurance, to the extent permitted by applicable law. Granter also will pay any court costs, in addition to all other sums provided by law.

NOTICES TO GRANTOR AND OTHER PARTIES. Any notice under this Mortgage, including without limitation any notice of default and any notice of gale to Grantor, shall be in writing and shall be effective when actually delivered or, if mailing, shall be deemed effective when deposited in the United States mail first class, registered mail, postage propaid, directed to the addresses shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. Any party may change its address for notices under this Mortgage by giving formal written notice to the other parties, specifying that the purpose of the notice is to change the party's address. All copies of notices of foreclosure from the holder of any lien which has prior to ever this Mortgage shall be sent to Lunder's address, as shown near the beginning of this Mortgage. For notice purposes, Grantor agrees to keep Lender informed at all times of Grantor's current address,

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS. The following miscellaneous provisions are a part of this Mortgage:

Amendments. This Mortgage, together with any Related Documents, constitutes the entire understanding and agreement of the parties set forth in this Mortgage. No alteration of or amendment to this Mortgage shall be effective unless given in writing and signed by the party or parties sought to be charged or bound by the alteration or amendment.

Applicable Law. This Mortgage has been delivered to Lender and accepted by Lender in the State of illinois. This Mortgage shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

Caption Headings. Caption headings in this Mortgage are for convenience purposes only and are not to be used a interpret or define the provisions of this Mortgage.

Merger. There shall be no merger of the interest or estate created by this Mortgage with any other interest or estate in the Proporty at any time held by or for the benefit of Lander in any capacity, without the written consent of Lander.

Multiple Parties. All obligations of Grantor under this Mortgage shall be joint and several, and all references to Grantor shall mean each and every Grantor. This means that each of the persons signing below is responsible for all obligations in this Mortgage.

Severability. If a court of computent jurisdiction finds any provision of this Mortgage to be invalid or unenforceable as to any person or circumstance, such finding shall not render that provision invalid or unenforceable as to any other persons or circumstances. If feasible, any such offending provision shall be deemed to be modified to be within the limits of enforceability or validity; however, if the offending provision cannot be so modified, it shall be stricken and all other provisions of this Mortgage in all other respects shall remain valid and enforceable.

Successors and Assigns. Subject to the limitations stated in this Mortgage on transfer of Grantor's interest, this Mortgage shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and assigns. If ownership of the Property becomes vested in a person other than Grantor, Lender, without notice to Grantor, may deal with Grantor's successors with reference to this Mortgage and the Indebtudness by way of forbearance or extension without releasing Grantor from the obligations of this Mortgage or liability under the Indebtudness.

Time is of the Essence. Time is of the essence in the performance of this Mortgage.

Walver of Homestead Exemption. Grantor hereby releases and waives all rights and benefits of the homestead exemption laws of the State of Illinois as to all indebtedness secured by this Mortgage

Walvers and Consents. Lender shall not be deemed to have walved any rights under this Mortgage (or under the Related Documents) unless such walver is in writing and signed by Lender. No delay or omission on the part of Lender in exorcising any right shall operate as a walver of such right or any other right. A walver by any party of a provision of this Mortgage shall not constitute a walver of or projudice the party's right

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otherwise to demand strict compliance with that provision or any other provision. No prior waiver by Lender, nor any course of dealing between Lender and Grantor, shall constitute a waiver of any of Lender's rights or any of Grantor's obligations as to any future transactions. Whenever consent by Lender is required in this Mortgage, the granting of such consent by Lender in any instance shall not constitute continuing consent to subsequent instances where such consent is required.
