Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any intendst, additional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto; shall be a illen in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or personal, belonging to such person.

Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by law, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount se assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such flability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of tapse

Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(a) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests, Mechanic's Llenors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (f) has been filed by the Secretary.

@ Place For Filing Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filling - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be filed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) Real Property - In the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which this property subject to the lien is situated, or

With Clerk Of District Court-In the office of the clerk of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements of subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Cf Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia, if the property subject to the lien is situated in the District of

(2) Situs Of Property Subject To Lien - For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), properly shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property - In the case of real property, at its physical legation; or

Sersonal Property - In the case of personal property, (3) er tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of ten is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (8), the residence of a corporation or partix (shir shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executr a or co of the business is located, and the residence of a largariar whose residence is without the United States shall be use ned to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form - The form and content of the notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be prescribed by the Secretary Such notice shall be valid notwinist incord any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a robos of lien

(c) Refiling Of Notice. - For purposals of this **5000001**

(t) General Rule. - Unless indice of fien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required refling period, such notice of lien shall be treated all filed on the date on which it is filed (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such rations period.

(3) Required Refiling Period.—in the case any notice of lien, the term "required refiling period" means -(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tex, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 ers after the close of the preceding required reliting period for such notice of lien.

> Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. - Subject to such regulations as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall leave a certificate of release of any lien imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on which -

(1) Liability Sabsfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the liability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become legally unenforceable, or

(2) Bond Accepted-There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment of the amount assessed, together with all Interest in respect thereof, rumin the time prescribed by law (including any extension of , uch tirlle), and that is in accordance with such requirements relained to terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations.

> Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return Information.

O Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes. -

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien.-If a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory written evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property,
