THIS TRUST DEED, made January 25, 1990, between Harry P. Jackson, Jr. married to Geneva Jackson

herein referred to as "Mortgagors," and Edward P. Cremerius of Palatine Cook County, Illinois, herein referred to as TRUSTEE, witnesseth THAT, WHEREAS the Mortgagors are justly indebted to the legal holders of the Promissory Note (herein called "Note") hereinafter described, said legal holder or holders being herein referred to as Holders of the Note evidenced by one certain Promissory Note of the Mortgagors of even date herewith, made payable as stated therein and delivered, in and by which said Note the Mortgagors promise to pay an Amount Financed of Fifty Eight Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-six and 71/100 (\$58576.71) Dollars with interest thereon, payable in installments as follows: Seven Hundred Eighty and 09/100 (\$780.09) Dollars or more on the 15th day of March 1990, and Seven Hundred Eighty and 09/100 (\$780.09) Dollars or more on the same day of each month thereafter, until said Agreement is fully paid and except that the final payment, if not sooner paid, shall be due on the 15th day of February, 2005.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mortgagors to secure the payment of the said sum of money in accordance with the terms, provisions and limitations of this trust deed, and the performance of the covenants and agreements herein contained, by the Mortgagors to be performed, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents CONVEY and WARRANT unto the Trustee, its successors and assigns the following described Real Estate and all of their estate, right, title and interest therein, situate, lying and being in the COUNTY OF Cook AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, to wit:

LOT 4 IN FOLEY'S SUBDIVISION OF LOTS 17 AND 18 IN BLOCK 2, IN ADAMS AND BROWNS ADDITION TO EVANSTON, BEING A SUBDIVISION OF PART OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE SOUTH WEST 1/4 OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 41 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, LYING EAST OF THE CENTER OF RIDGE ROAD (EXCEPT THE SOUTH 2 FEET), IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the premises unto the said Trustee, its successors and assigns, forever, for the purposes and upon the uses and trusts herein set forth, free from all rights and benefits under and by virtue of the Homestead Exemption Laws of the State of Illinois, which said rights and benefits the Mortgagors do hereby expressly release and waive.

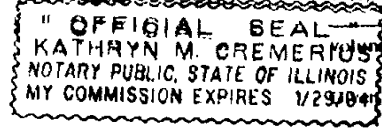
