3. That on August 10, 1989, recorded legal title to the foregoing premises was held by WEST BANK ATRIUM LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, an Illinois limited parcreship, (hereinafter referred to as the "Owner"). That said Owner, as lessor, and BILLY LEE'S LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, an Illinois limited partnership, as lessee/agent, (hereinafter referred to as "Agent") entered into a lease of the premises for the operation of a restaurant and family entertainment center by lessee on the premises. That prior to that date the said Agent authorized or knowingly remitted by Owner to make said contract entered into a contract with STEINBERG & CRANE, INC. as original contractor, for the furnishing and supplying of certain materials, services, labor, work and lixitutes for the construction and remodeling of said premises for the lenstruction of a restaurant and family entertainment center. That an or about the aforesaid day, to wit, August 10, 1989, the said contractor entered into an oral contract with the claimant, CROICH-WALKER CORPORATION to furnish labor and materials for repair and installation of stairwells, masonry, plastering, and interior walls, all of which labor and materials were incorporated in, and upon and for the building and improvements on the foregoing doscribed premises, on a time and material basis, plus a fee for overhead and profit, plus any extras that may be contracted for from time to time, which sums were to be payable in monthly progress payments of 90% of the value of labor and material in place at the end of the preceding month, payable on the 30th day of the following month less retention, with the balance due upon completion.

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- 4. That all of the said materials, work, labor and services so furnished, delivered, and installed by the claimant, including approved extras, in the amount of \$85,109.57 was furnished and delivered to, and used in and about the improvements thereon; that the last of said materials, work, labor and services including extras, was furnished, delivered and performed on December 5, 1989.
- Claimant served copies of its Subcontractor's 90-Day Notice of Lien on Spatz & Company and Steinberg-Crane, on December 29, 1989; and copies were served on West Bank Atrium Limited Partnership and LaSalle National Bank on February 6, 1990, all by certified mail, return receipt requested.
- That there is now justly due and owing to claimant, for the furnishing, delivery and installation of said materials, work, labor and services, as aforesaid, including all extras, after allowing to Owner all credits, deductions and off-sets, the sum of \$85,109.57, all of which amount is still due and unpaid.
- That the above-named claimant now claims a lien upon the above-described premises and all improvements thereon, against all persons interested, and also claims a lien upon the money, or other consideration due from the aforesaid Owner to the original contractor, for the amount of Eighty Five Thousand One Hundred Nine & 57/100th (\$85,109.57) Dollars, together with interest according to the statute.
