The covenants, conditions and provisions listed below among other things, equire Mortgagors to keep the premises in repair, insured and free of lieng and to may and discharge prior liens and taxes, provide that if not paid by Mortgapors, the costs of such repairs, insurance, prior liens and taxes paid by Mortgagee constitute additional indebtedness secured hereby, provide for tax and insurance deposits, for acceleration of maturity of the Note and foreclosure hereof in case of default and for the allowance of Mortgagee's attorneys' fees and expenses of foreclosure, and are incorporated herein by reference, are a part hereof, and shall be binding on the Mortgagors and those claiming through them.

In the event Mocti agors sell or convey the premises, or if the title thereto or any interest legal or equitable therein shall become vested in any manner whatsoever in any other person or persons other than Mortgagors, or if Mortgagors is a trust in persons than Mortgagors's bin ficiaries, Mortgagee shall have the option of declaring immediately due and payable all unpaid balances on the Note and enforcing the provision of this mortgage with respect there to unless prior to such sale or conveyance Mortgagee shall have consented thereto in writing and the prospective purchasers or grantees shall have executed a writter agreement in form satisfactory to the Mortgagee assuming and agreeing to be bound by the terms and conditions of said Note and this Mortgage.

COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND PROVISIONS:

1. Mortgagors covenant and agree o pay said indebtedness and the interest thereon as herein and in said Note or other evidence thereof provided, or according to any agreement extending the time of payment thereof; (2) To pay when due and before any penalty attaches thereto all taxes, special taxes, special assessments, water charges, and service charges against the premises (including those heretofore due), and to furnish Hortgagee, upon request, duplicate receipts therefor, and all such items extended against said premises shall be conclusively demonstrated as the Mortragee may require to be insured requirement; (3) To keep the improvements now or Vereafter upon said premises insured against damage by fire, and such other hazards as the Mortragee may require to be insured against; and to provide liability insurance and such other insurance as the Mortragee may require, until said indebtedness is fully paid, or in lase of foreclosure, until expiration of the period of redemntion, for the full insurable value thereof, in such companies, and in such form as shall be satisfactory to the Mortragee; such insurance policies shall remain with the Mortragee during said period of periods, and contain the means clause satisfactory to the Mortragee making them payable to the Mortragee; and in against said premises shall be conclusively dremed valid for the purpose of this requirement; (3) To keep the improvements now or hereafter upon said premises insured case of foreclosure sale payable to the owner of the certificate of cale, owner of any deficiency, any receiver or redemptioner, or any grantee in a deed; and in case of loss under such policies, the Mortgages is authorized to adjust, collect and congromise, in its discretion, all claims thereunder and to execute and deliver on behalf of the Mortgagers all necessary proofs of loss, receipts, vouchers, releases and acquittances required to be signed by the insurance companies, and the Mortgagors agree to sign, upon demand, all receipts, vouchers and releases required of them to be signed by the Mortgagee for such purpose; and the Mortgagee is authorized to apply the roceeds of any insurance claim to the restoration of the premises or upon the indebtedness hereby secured in its discretion, but monthly payments shall continue until said indebtedness is paid in full; (4) immediately after destruction or damage, to commence and promptly complete the rebuilding or restoration of buildings and improvements now or hereafter on said premises, unless Mortgagee elects to apply on the indebtedness secured hereby the proceeds of any insurance covering such destruction or damage; (5) To keep said premises in good condition and repair, without waste, and free from any methanics' or other lies or claim of lien not expressly subordinated in writing to the lien hereof; (6) Not to more, suffer or permit any unlawful use of or any nulsance to suist on said premises not to diminish nor impair its value by any act or ombossion to act: (7) To comply with all requirements of law with respect to the premies and the use thereof; (8) Not to make, suffer or permit, without the written permission of the Mortgagee being first had and obtained, (a) any use of the premises for any purpose other than that for which it is now used, (r) any alterations of

Any costs and expendent reasonably incurred in the foreclosure of this mortgage and sale of the property securing the same and in connection with any other dispute or litigation affecting said debt or lian, including reasonably estimated amounts to conclude the transaction, shall be added to and be a part of the debt hereby secured. All such amounts shall be payable by the Mortgagors to the Mortgagee on demand, and if not paid shall be included in any decree or judgment as a part of said mortgage debt and shall include interest at the rate of PRIME+35 per cent per annum.

4. In case of default therein, Mortgagee may, but need not, make any payment or perform any act herein required of Mortgagors in any form and manner deemed expedient, and may, but need not, make full or partial payments of principal or interest on prior encumbrances, if any, and purchase, discharge, complouise or settle any tax lien or other prior lien or title or claim thereof, or redeem from any tax sale or forfeiture affecting said premises or contest any tax or assessment. All moneys paid for any of the purposes herein authorized and all expenses paid or incurred in connection therewith, including attorneys' fees, and any other moneys advanced by Mortgagee in its discretion to protect the premises and the lien hereof, shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby and shall become immediately due and payable without notice and with interest thereon at the rate of PRIME+3; per cent per annum. Innoction of Mortgagee shall never be considered as a waiver of any right according to it on account of any default hereunder on the part of the Mortgageers.

5. Mortgagee making any payment hereby authorized relating to takes of times shends, may do so according to any bill, statement or estimate produced from the appropriate public office without inquiry into the accuracy of such bill, statement or estimate of into the validity of any tax, assessment, sale, forfeiture, tax ligh or title or claim thereof.

6. At the option of the Mortgagee and without demand upon or notice to Mortgagots, all unpaid indebtedness secured by this Mortgage shall, notwithoushding anything in the Note or in this hortgage to the contrary, become due and payable when default shall occur and continue for three days in the performance of any other agreement of the Mortgagors herein contained.

7. In the event that Mortgagors or either of them (a) consent to the appointment of a receiver, trystee, or liquidator of all or a substantial part of Mortgagors' assets, or (b) be adjudicated a bankrupt or insolvent, or file a voluntary petition in bankruptcy, of admit in writing their inability to pay debts as they become due, or (c) make a general assignment for the benefit of creditors, or (d) file a petition or answer seeking reorganization or arrangement with creditors, or to take adventage of any insolvency law for (e) file an answer admitting the material allegations of a petition filed against Mortgagors in any backruptcy, reorganization, or insolvency proceeding, or (f) take any

action for the purpose of effecting any of the foregoing, or (g) any order, judgment +cdecree shall be entered upon an application of a creditor of the Mortgagors by a court c: competent jurisdiction approving a petition seeking appointment of a receiver or trustee of all or a substantial part of the Mortgagors' assets and such order, juigment or decree shall continue unstayed and in effect for any period of 30 consecutive days, the holder of the Note may declare the Note forthwith due and payable, whereupon the principal an interest accrued on the Note and all other sums hereby secured, shall become forthwith du and payable as if all of the said sums of money were originally stipulated to be paid on such date; and thereupon the Mortgagee without notice or demand, may prosecute a suit at law and/or in equity as if all money secured hereby had matured prior to its institution. Furthermore, if foreclosure proceedings should be instituted against the premises upon any other lien or claim, the Norgagee may at its option immediately upon institution of such suit or during the pendency thereof declare this Mortgage and the incebtedness secured hereby due and payable forthwith and may at its option proceed to foreclosure this Mortgage.

When the indebtedness hereby secured shall become due whether by demand, ٤. acceleration or otherwise, Mortgagee small have the right to foreclose the lien hereof, in any suit to foreclose the lien hereof, there shall be allowed and included as additional indebtedness in the decree for sale all expenditutes and expenses which may be paid to incurred by for on behalf of Mortgagee for attorneys' fees, appraisers' fees, outlays for documentary and expert evidence, stenographers' charges, publication costs and costs (which may be excepted as to items to be expended after entry of the decree) of procuring all such abstracts of title, title searches and examinations, guarantee policies, Torrens certificates and similar data and assurances with respect to table as hortgaged may deem to be reasonably necessary either to prosecute such suit or to evidence to bidders at any sale which may be had pursuant to such decree the true condition of the title or the value of the premises. 9. The proceeds of any foreclosure sale of the premises shall be distributed and applied in the following order of priority. First, on account of all costs and expenses incident to the foreclosure proceedings, including all such items as are mentioned in the preceding paragraph hereof; second, all other items which under the terms hereof constitute secured indebtedness additional to that evidenced by the Note with interest thereon as herein provided; third, all principal and interest remaining unpaid on the Note: fourth, any surplus to Mortgagors, their heirs legal representatives or assigns, as their rights may appear.

10. Upon, or at any time after the filling of suit to foreclose this Mortgage, the Court in which such suit is filed may appoint a receiver of said premises. Such appointment may be made either before or after sale, without notice, without regard to the solvency or insolvency of Mordgagors at the time of application for such receiver and without regard to the then value of the premises or whether the same shall be then occupied as a homestesi or not, and the Mortgagee may be appointed as such receiver. Such pereiver shall have power to collect the rents, issues and profits of said premises during the pendency of such foreclusure suit and, in case of a sale and a lediciency, during the full statutory period of redemption, whether there be redemption or not, as well as during any further times when Mortgagors, except for the intervention of such deceiver, would be entitled to collect such rents, issues and profits, and all other powers which may be necessary or are usual in such cases for the protection (including insurance and repairs). possession, control, management and operation of the premises during the whole of said period. The Mortgagors will not at any time insist upon, or plead, or in any manner whatsoever claim or take any benefit or advantage of, any stay or entension or moratorium law, any exemption from execution or sale of the premises or any part thereof, wherever enacted, now or at any time heroliter enforced, which may affect the terms and covenants er the performance of this Mortgage, not claim, take, or insist upon any benefit or advantage of any law now or hereafter in force providing for the valuation or appraisal of the premises, or any part thereof, prior to any sale or sales thereof which may be made pursuant to any provision herein, or pursuant to the decree, judgment, or order of any

Eourt of competent jurisdiction; and the Mortgagors hereby expressly waive all benefit or

court of competent jurisdiction; and the Mortgagora hereby expressly waive all benefit or advantage of any such law or laws, and covenant not to hinder, delay, or impede the execution of any power herein granted or delegated to the Mortgagee, but to suffer and permit the execution of every power as though no such law or laws had been made or enacted. The Mortgagora, for itself or themselves and all who may claim under it or them, waive, to the extent that it may lawfully do so, all right to have the mortgaged property marshaled upon any foreclosure hereof.

12. No action for the enforcement of the lien or of any provision hereof shall be subject to any defense which would not be good and available to the party interposing same

in an action at law upon the Note.

13. In case the premises, or any part thereof, shall be taken by condemnation, the Mortgagee is hereby empowered to collect and receive all compensation which may be paid for any property taken or for damages to any property not taken and all comdemnation compensation so received shall be forthwith applied by the Mortgagee as it may elect, to the immediate reduction of the indebtedness secured hereby, or to the repair and restoration of any property so damaged, provided that any excess over the amount of the

indebtedness shall be delivered to the Mortgagors or their assigned.

14. All avails, rents, issues and profits of the premises are pledged, assigned and the Mortgagee, whether now due or hereafter to become due, under or by transferred virtue of an lease or agreement for the use or occupancy of said premises, or any part thereof, whether said lease or agreement is written or verbal, and it is the intention hereof (a) to pledge said rents, issues and profits on a parity with said real estate and and such pledge shall not be deemed merged in any foreclosure decree, and not secondarily to establish an absolute transfer and assignment to the Mortgagee of all such leases (b) and agreements and all the avails thereunder, together with the right in case of default, either before or after foreclosure sale, to enter upon and take possession of, manage, maintain and operate fald premises, or any part thereof, make leases for terms deamed advantageous to it, terminate or modify existing or future leases, collect said avails, rents, issues and profit: egardless of when earned, and use such measures whether legal or equitable as it may deem proper to enforce collection thereof, employ renting agents or other employees, alter or tendir said premises, buy furnishings and equipment therefor when it deems necessary, purchase adequate fire and extended coverage and other forms of insurance as may be deemed addisable, and in general exercise all powers ordinarily incident to absolute ownership, edvance or borrow money necessary for any purpose herein stated to secure which a lien is hereby created on the premises and on the income therefrom which lien is prior to the lien of any other indebtedness hereby secured, and out of the income retain reasonable compensation for itself, pay insurance premiums, taxes and assessments, and all expenses of every kind, including attorney's fees, incurred in the exercise of the powers herein given, and from time to time apply any balance of income not, in its sole discretion, needed for the process, first on the interest and then on the principal of the indebtedness hareby secured, before or after any decree of foreclosure, and on the deficiency in the precedes of sale, if any, whether there be a decree in personam therefor or not. In the event new buildings and improvements are now being or are to be elected or placed on the premises (that is, if this is a construction lear mortgage) and it hortgagers do not complete the construction of said buildings and improvements in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by Mortgagee, on or before thirty days prior to the due date of the first payment of principal, or if work on said construction should cease before completion and the said work should remain abandoned for a period of thirty days, then and in either event, the entire principal sum of the Note secured by this Mortgage and interest thereon shall at once become due and payable, at the option of Mortgagee, and in the event of abandonment of work upon the construction of the said buildings or improvements for the period of thirty days as aforesaid, Mortgagee may, at its option, also enter into and upon the mortgaged premises and complete the construction of the said buildings and improvements and moneys expended by Mortgagee in connection with such completion of construction shall be added to the principal amount of said Note and secured by these presents, and shall be payable by Mortgagers on demand, with interest at the rate of PRIME+31 per cent per annum. In the event Mortgages
