

# Excerpts From Internal Revenue Code

## Sec. 6321. Lien For Taxes

If any person liable to pay any tax neglects or refuses to pay the same after demand, the amount (including any interest, adcitional amount, addition to tax, or assessable penalty, together with any costs that may accrue in addition thereto) shall be a lien in favor of the United States upon all property and rights to property, whether real or paraonal; belonging to such person.

# Sec. 6322. Period Of Lien.

Unless another date is specifically fixed by lew, the lien imposed by section 6321 shall arise at the time the assessment is made and shall continue until the liability for the amount so assessed (or a judgment against the taxpayer arising out of such fiability) is satisfied or becomes unenforceable by reason of lapse

### Sec. 6323. Validity and Priority Against Certain Persons.

(e) Purchaser's, Holders Of Security Interests; Mechanic's Lienors, And Judgment Lien Creditors. - The lien imposed by section 6321 shall not be valid as against any purchaser, holder of a security interest, mechanic's lienor, or judgment lien creditor until notice thereof which meets the requirements of subsection (I) has been filed by the Secretary. 1789

#### in Place For Filling Notice; Form.-

(1) Place For Filing - The notice referred to in subsection (a) shall be illed -

(A) Under State Laws

(i) "Real Property" in the case of real property, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; and

(ii) Personal Property - In the case of personal property, whether tangible or intangible, in one office within the State (or the county, or other governmental subdivision), as designated by the laws of such State, in which the property subject to the lien is situated; or

With Clark Of District Court-In the office of the clark of the United States district court for the judicial district in which the property subject to lien is situated, whenever the State has not by law designated one office which meets the requirements

ol subparagraph (A), or

(C) With Recorder Of Deeds Of The District Of Columbia-In the office of the Recorder of Deeds of the District of Columbia. If the property subject to the lien is altuated in the District of Columbia.

(2)" Situs Of Property Subject To Lien & For purposes of paragraphs (1) and (4), property shall be deemed to be situated -

(A) Real Property . In the case of real property, at its physical location; or

Personal Property - In the case of personal property, hother tangible or intangible, at the residence of the taxpayer at the time the notice of lien is filed.

For purposes of paragraph (2) (B), the residence of a corporation or partn rish) shall be deemed to be the place at which the principal executive office of the business is located, and the justdence of a tarular whose residence is without the United States shall be us med to be in the District of Columbia.

(3) Form . The form and content of the notice referred to the subsection (a) shall be proscribed by the Societary. Such . notice shall be valid notwill a laiding any other provision of law regarding the form or content of a notice of fien.

- (9) Refiling Of Notice. For purposes of this section -
- (t) General Rule. -- Unless notice of lien is refiled in the manner prescribed in paragraph (2) during the required reliling period, such notice of lien shall be treated as filled on the date on which it is filled (in accordance with subsection (f)) after the expiration of such refiling period.
- (2) Place For Filing. -- A notice of tion refiled during the required refiling period shall be effective only -

(A)

(i) such notice of tien is refilled in the office in which the prior notice of lien was filed, and

(ii) in the case of real property, the fact of rollling is entered and recorded in an index to the extent required by subsection (f) (4), and

(3) in any case in which, 90 days or more prior to the date of a refiling of notice of lien under subparagraph (A), the Secretary' received written information fin-the manner prescribed in regulations issued by the Secretary) concerning a change in the taxpayer's residence, if a notice of such lian is also filed in accordance with subsection (f) in the State in which such residence is located.

(3). Required Refilling Period. — in the case of any notice of lion, the torm frequired reflling period" means -

(A) the one-year period ending 30 days after the expiration of 6 years after the date of the assessment of the tax, and (B) the one-year period ending with the expiration of 6 years after the close of the preceding required reliling period for such notice of lien. 

# Sec. 6325. Release Of Lien Or Discharge Of Property.

(a) Release Of Lien. — Subject to such regula-tions as the Secretary may prescribe, the Secretary shall issue a certificate of rolease of any lion imposed with respect to any internal revenue tax not later than 30 days after the day on

(1) Liability Satisfied or Unenforceable - The Secretary finds that the flability for the amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, has been fully satisfied or has become

legally unanforceable; or

(2) Bond Accepted There is furnished to the Secretary and accepted by him a bond that is conditioned upon the payment he amount assessed, together with all interest in respect thereof, and the time prescribed by law (including any extension of such that), and that is in accordance with such requirements relating a terms, conditions, and form of the bond and sureties thereon as may be specified by such regulations

# Sec. 6103. Confidentiality and Disclosure of Returns and Return, Information.

(k) Disclosure of Certain Returns and Return Information For Tax Administration Purposes,-

(2) Disclosure of amount of outstanding lien, if a notice of lien has been filed pursuant to section 6323(f), the amount of the outstanding obligation secured by such lien may be disclosed to any person who furnishes satisfactory writion evidence that he has a right in the property subject to such lien or intends to obtain a right in such property.
